Council met on June 3, 1947, for the transaction of general business, all members present with the exception of Robt. McFadden, Stuart Howey, Esq. Reeve, presided.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Live stock claims to the total of \$238.00 were received and payment authorized.

Morrow - Sowerby—That the Treasurer receive the sum of \$3.00, balance due from hall operation for month of May, 1947.—Carried.

Morrow - Jackson—That the Clerk be instructed to notify the attendance officer to see about the non-attendance of a pupil of U.S.S. 11, Holland and Sydenham, namely Clifford Byers, who has been absent for four months, this fact having been regularly reported to the attendance officer.—Carried.

Jackson - Morrow—That the County Treasurer be authorized to arise from his roll the arrears of taxes on Lots E Pt. 27 and 28, 5 EGR, for the year 1943, as same has been received by the collector.—Carried.

Sowerby - Jackson—That the following accounts as recommended by the Board of Health for Dental Care of children be paid: Dr. Baxendale, \$102.66; Dr. Bebee, \$44.00; Dr. McKee, \$14.00; Dr. McArthur, \$74.00; Dr. Cheetham, \$78.00.

Deduction of \$17.00 being made from original account of Dr. Cheetham as same was charged in error.—Carried.

Morrow - Jackson—That Clerk be instructed to send accounts for auditing school books to the various school boards.—Carried.

Morrow - Sowerby—That the indigent account of Durham Memorial Hospital be not paid and notification of Council decision be forwarded to the proper authorities.—Carried.

Jackson - Morrow—That the Treasurer receive the sum of \$38.00 balance in full due from Massie Snow Club for 1946-1947 season, also \$14.9 from Strathaven Club and \$40.70 from Spring Hill Snow Club.—Carried.

Jackson - Morrow—That Road Superintendent Pay Roll and Voucher No. 6, amounting to \$402.60, be paid and Treasurer issue cheques for same.—Carried.

Jackson - Sowerby—That leave be granted to introduce a by-law to approve of an extension of the East-Grey Telephone System in Holland Township.—Carried.

Leave granted and by-law read a first time.

Morrow - Sowerby—That the Clerk be instructed to advertise for sufficient land adjacent to the villages of Walters Falls, Berkeley and Holland Centre to be used for the purpose of a dumping ground for refuse.—Carried.

Sowerby - Jackson—That the Road Superintendent be instructed to investigate the request of John Craven and supply tile where necessary.—Carried.

Jackson - Morrow—That by-law 204 be now read a second time.—Carried.

Sowerby - Morrow—That by-law 204 be now read a third time finally passed, signed by the Reeve and Clerk and engrossed in the by-law book.—Carried.

Jackson - Morrow—That leave be granted to introduce a by-law to incorporate certain school sections into the Township School Area.—Carried.

Leave granted and by-law read a first time.

Morrow - Jackson—That by-law 205 be now read a second time.—Carried.

Morrow - Jackson—That by-law 205 be now read a third time, finally passed, signed by the Reeve and Clerk and engrossed in the by-law book.—Carried.

Jackson - Morrow—That the Reeve be instructed to interview Glenelg Township re culvert on Townline Holland and Glenelg and provided same is satisfactory, to order culvert from Roofers Supply Co. per W. O. Fawcette.—Carried.
