The Rock Garden
A rock garden is not only a decorative feature—it can become one of the most fascinating hobbies. It challenges your ingenuity, and also requires you with many plans.

Your soil pockets should be deep and rich with a good soil mixture—equal parts of peat, loam and sand. For plants demanding acid soil, use more sand, with little powdered lime or ground limestone.

In choosing plant materials try to carry the bloom through the season. Too many rock gardens are "spring gardens" only.

At first a few of the smaller flowering plants from the garden border can be included, such as sweet william, dwarf anemones, low bushy marigolds.

One homeowner who had no natural slope but simply a rectangular town lot like those of all his neighbors, built a brick wall (his home was brick and stone) along one boundary of his grounds, imported some soil and rocks for an artificial slope and built a rock garden against the wall.

A flat rectangular lot, however, poses a problem. In most such cases it is best to leave rock gardens to others, unless a sunken formal garden with a fountain or pool can be surrounded by grassed or flagged terraces held by planted dry walls.

Native stone is the best material. The test is to make a look "geologically probable". The rocks should be fairly large, and uplited to send the moisture back into V-shaped
