### The Right Way to Lift

A Canadian farmer noted for his strength and also for his unassuming wisdom was asked how he managed to lift such heavy weights. "Well," he answered, "I am naturally strong, but a man might be as strong as an ox, and yet strain his back in lifting a comparatively light weight, if he lifts the wrong way. Don't lift with your back. Lift with your legs by bending your knees, and keep your back as straight as possible without straining to do so. That is, keep your back as vertical as possible to the ground when lifting. "And don't show off. If you find you cannot heave a sack or anything else unaided onto your shoulders, get someone to give a hand. If the weight to be lifted is too heavy to carry alone, don't have false pride, get help. There is a limit in everyone to the amount of strain the muscles will stand, especially on your back. And the way to lift is to lift with the legs. They are the natural elevators."

### THE BEST INSURANCE IS A GOOD WIFE

The best insurance a man can have against accidental fires in his home is to possess a wife who is a good housekeeper, recently stated a fire chief.

"A wife who is a good housekeeper will remove many of the hazards around a house," he declared. "She will keep the cellarway and the closets clear of waxing rags and she will keep waste in covered cans."

The fire chief emphasized that in addition to maintaining safe conditions inside factories, it was also important to clear waste from the factory grounds. He said that dried grass, cut and left in the sun, was a source of many fires in industrial buildings.

### CULL PULLETS CLOSELY

With the present high prices of feeds it becomes necessary for economical production, to feed only the birds giving evidence of high production.

During the growing and rearing season any pullet that develops slowly or shows lack of vigour, should be eliminated. Such birds rarely make high production records.

When transferring pullets from range to laying quarters every bird should be carefully handled, and culled from the flock unless it shows potential egg laying ability.

Small, weak, unthrifty pullets, as well as coarse, rough, meaty-headed birds should be discarded, says B. F. Tinney, Dominion Experimental Station, Charlottetown, P. E. I.

Select deep, full-bodied birds, broad backed and broad-breasted birds with clean cut head and face. Clean close feathering indicates health and vigour, as does also a bright, prominent eye and alert carriage.

Discard the boarder—keep only the worker.
