### Holland Council Minutes

April 5th, 1949.  
Council met on the above date for the transaction of general business, all members of Council present, Stuart Howey, Esq., Reeve, presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Tenders were received from Lawrence Farrow and Sandy Contracting Co. for crushing and hauling gravel. Applications for the position of grader operator were received from the following: Everett Ritchie, Albert Neagarth, Howard Bradley, John S. Caesar, Lloyd E. Weatherhead, Geo. Caswell, Mac Ratchliffe Norman Seabrook, Adrian T. McCasey, Charles Keffe.

Hansen - McFadden—That the tender of the Sandy Contracting Co. of Goderich for approximately 3,000 cu. yards of gravel, ½ size delivered on Township Roads at 67½¢ per cu. yard be accepted. Tender cheque now deposited with Clerk.—Carried.

McFadden - Morrow—That Treasurer receive the sum of \$3 payment from W. C. Seabrook on snowplowing account for Townline Holland and Euphrasia.—Carried.

Morrow - Hansen—That Treasurer receive the sum of \$17.55 payment on snowplowing account for 60 Sideroad East Snow Club.—Carried.

Morrow - Sellwood—That Albert Rice be appointed School Attendance Officer for Holland Township to replace Morrel Crawford, resigned.—Carried.

Morrow - Hansen—That Chas. McCallum be appointed Warble Fly Inspector for Holland, replacing John

Ramage, resigned, and that the rate of inspectors' pay be 60¢ per hour plus 7¢ per mile.—Carried.

Morrow - Hansen—That the tax collector be credited with \$4.11, same being taxes of 1948 on Lot 2A1, 8 E.G.R.—Carried.

Hansen - McFadden—That payroll and voucher No. 4, amounting to \$3,291.94 be passed and paid.—Cd.

Morrow - Sellwood—That the Hall caretaker be authorized to clean hall, and replace worn stove pipes, blacken stove, scrub floor and platform, clean all windows and electric fixtures, wash and replace curtains on platform, etc., for the sum of \$16.—Carried.

Hansen - McFadden—That this Municipal Council of the Township of Holland authorize the Department of Agriculture for the County of Grey to proceed with the campaign to have all heifer calves within the Township vaccinated for the prevention of Bangs disease, and that all the cattle owners within the Township to cooperate and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Agr. Rep. for Grey County.—Carried.

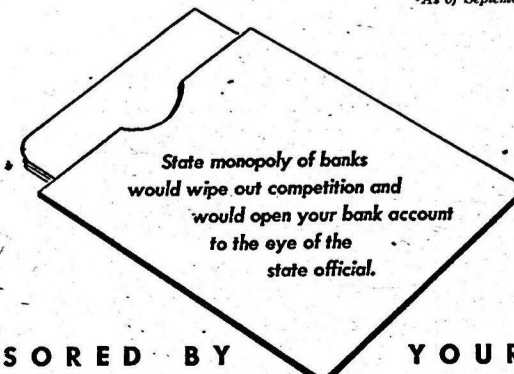
