RATE ON ALBERTA COAL APPLIES TO ALL POINTS ON ONTARIO RAILWAYS

The question of the reduced freight rate on Alberta coal applying to points on railways other than the C.P.R. and Canadian National, which has been taken up by the Boards of Trade in the North Country, has been solved to the satisfaction of the towns on the T. & N. O. The Secretary of the Haileybury Board of Trade has received this week a letter from the Board of Railway Commissioners which states clearly that the rate of \$6.75 per ton fixed by Order-in-Council covers all charges to all points in Ontario. The letter reads: "With further reference to your letter of the 26th ult., I am instructed to inform you that the Board has decided that the rate of \$6.75 fixed by Order-in-Council P.C. 439, is a uniform and maximum rate covering all movements of coal from Alberta shipping points to Ontario, including movements over more than one line of railway and switching

charges when a switching movement is necessary."

This makes the matter very clear and residents of the North Country may have no fear that they are being discriminated against in the rates on the coal.

Claim Fishing is Good in Flood at South Porcupine

An unusual feature of the floods which have been causing trouble in South Porcupine is the fact that fish have been washed up from the streams into the town. One day last week a resident of the gold camp caught a sucker right from the station platform. 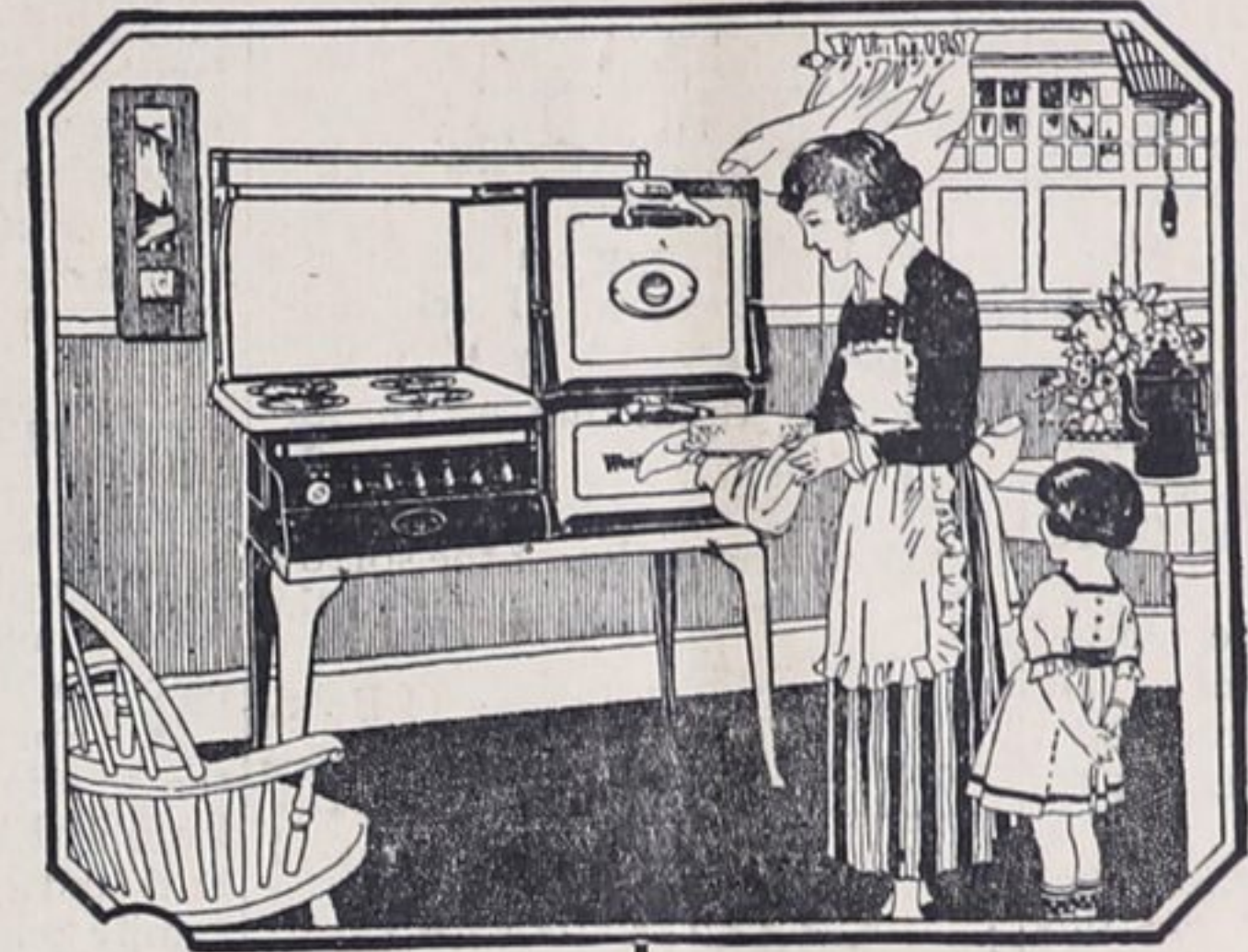
