

### Picture Location Makes Ideal Tourist Camp

Site of Indian Life Movie Made Recently, is Visited by Trio of Local Fishermen

### Woman River and Ridout Areas Are Covered by Report

A report of interest to prospectors has just been published by the Geological Survey. This is Memoir 157, Woman River and Ridout Map-areas, Sudbury District, by R. C. Emmons and Ellis Thomson. This area may be reached by canoe route from Ridout and Biscotasing station on the Canadian Pacific Railway, and from Stackpool and by way of the Groundhog river on the

Canadian National Railway.

Precambrian formations composed of volcanic and sedimentary series (all pre-Huronian), intrusive granite, and later diabase dykes comprise the rocks of the area. Iron formation occurs at the top of the sedimentary group and is well developed in the older volcanics.

The iron formation has been examined as a possible source of iron ore and bodies of iron pyrites are also found. In more recent years, however, interest has been centred mainly on deposits of lead, zinc, and copper sulphides.

These occur in veins that are in general parallel to the bedding of the iron formation, with minor cross veins.

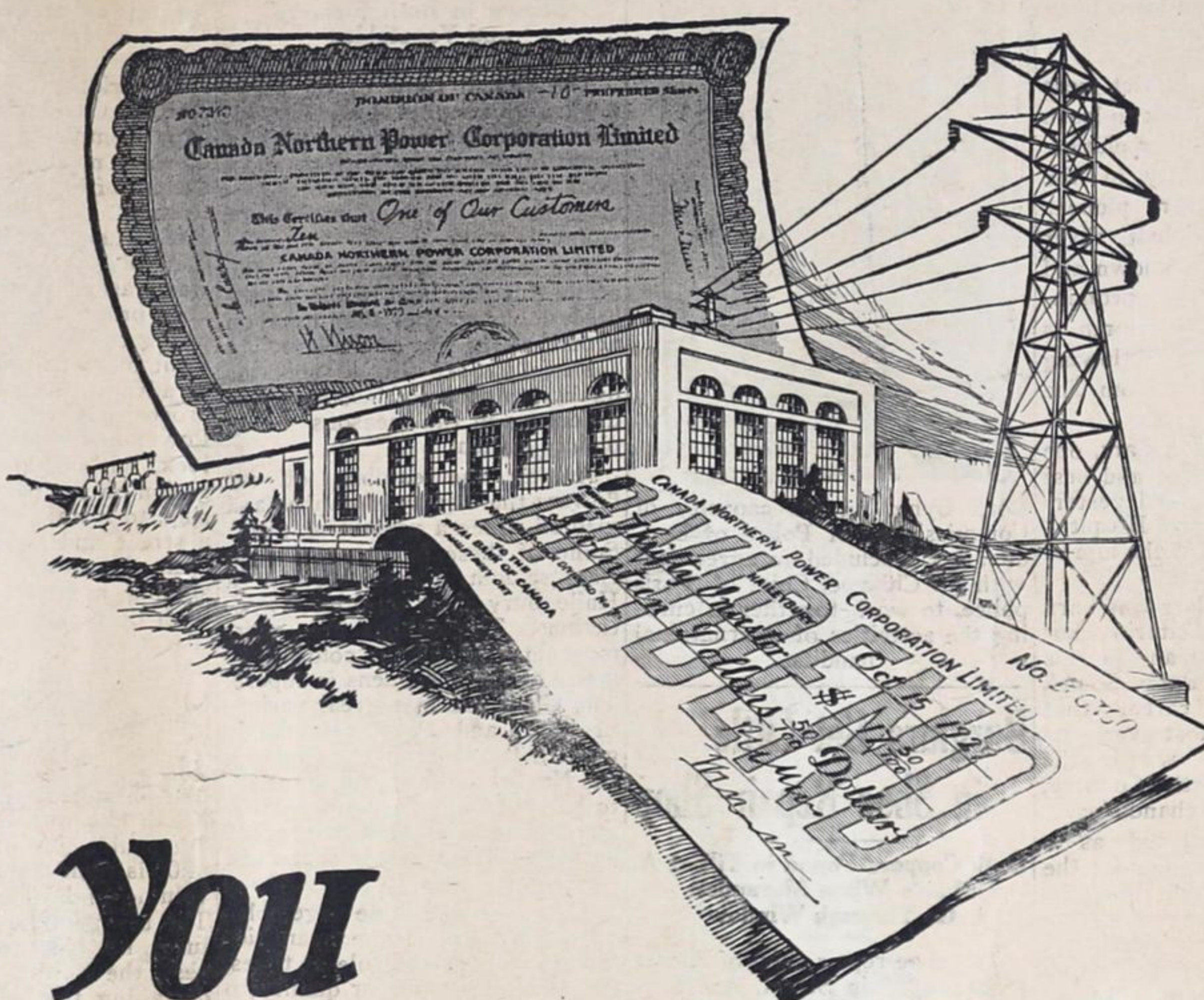
