

My foremost objective will be to secure from the Government a greatly increased amount of road money, which will enable us to do more work than ever on trunk and township roads and drains. Our trunk roads will be maintained and improved and our township or side roads will receive more than usual attention. One of my ambitions which I hope to see fulfilled is the construction of a concrete or asphalt road right through Temiskaming from the south to the north.

I intend to do everything in my power, irrespective of party politics, to advance the true interests of temperance in the Province and District and will not allow this moral and social question to be made a political football.

The education and welfare of the children of this district will always be prominent in my activities and whenever an opportunity offers itself I will avail myself of it to be of assistance to those interested in schools and other affairs where children are concerned.
