Pupils to Receive Toxoid Treatment

from diphtheria will be given the younger pupils at the public and separate schools here, under an arrangement by the Provincial Board of Health. This week the pupils were given cards to be signed by their parents or guardians authorizing the treatment which is described as a toxoid administration, on November 29th. The cards are to be signed and returned to the Public Health Nurse, through the teachers, if the parents are willing that the treatment should be administered, and parents are invited to be present. The consent of the parents or guardians is necessary.

The treatment is described as a safe and sure preventative of diphtheria and all are advised to have it administered. It has been developed along scientific lines as one of the measures that are put into effect in the interests of general health in any community.
