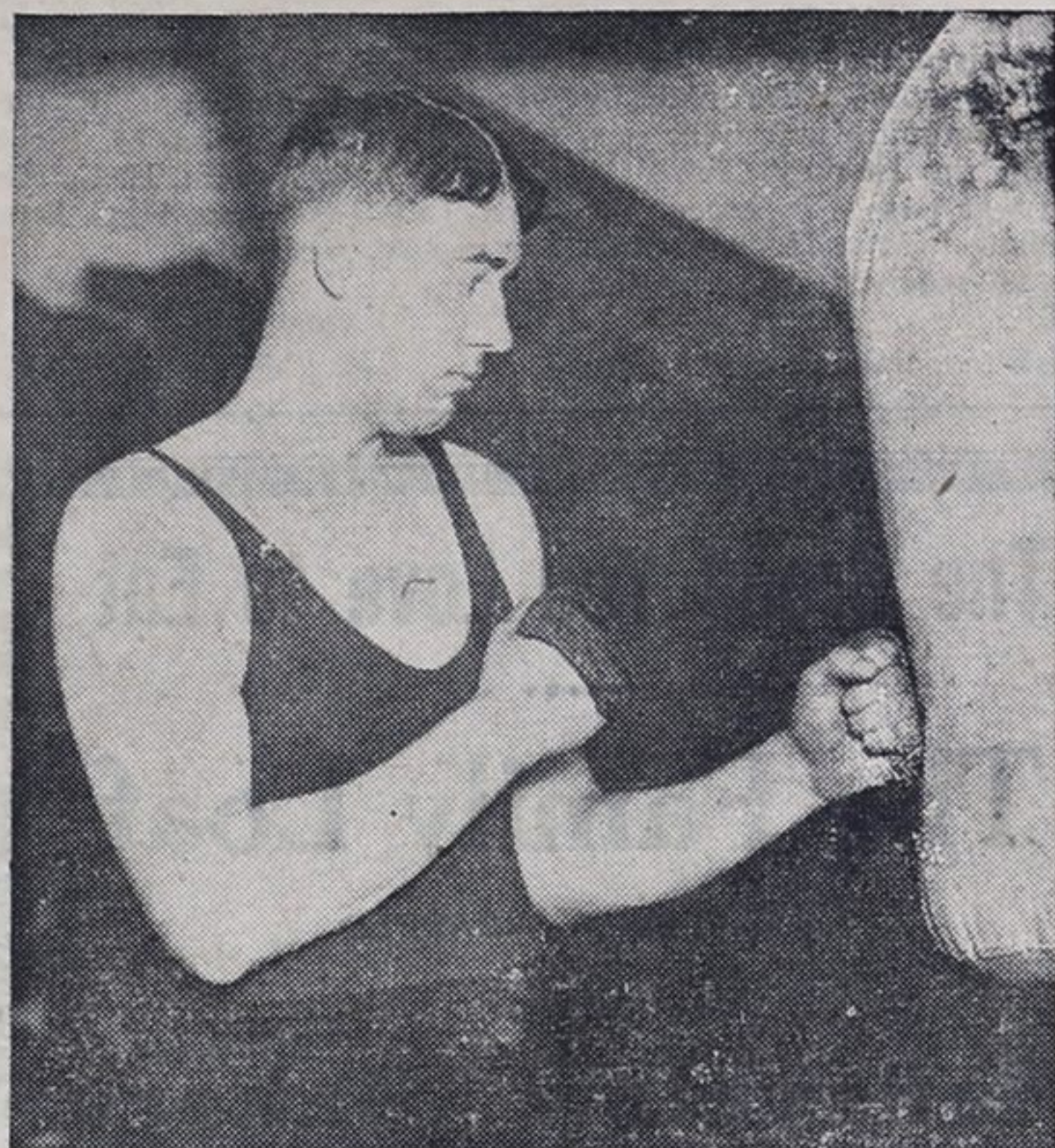

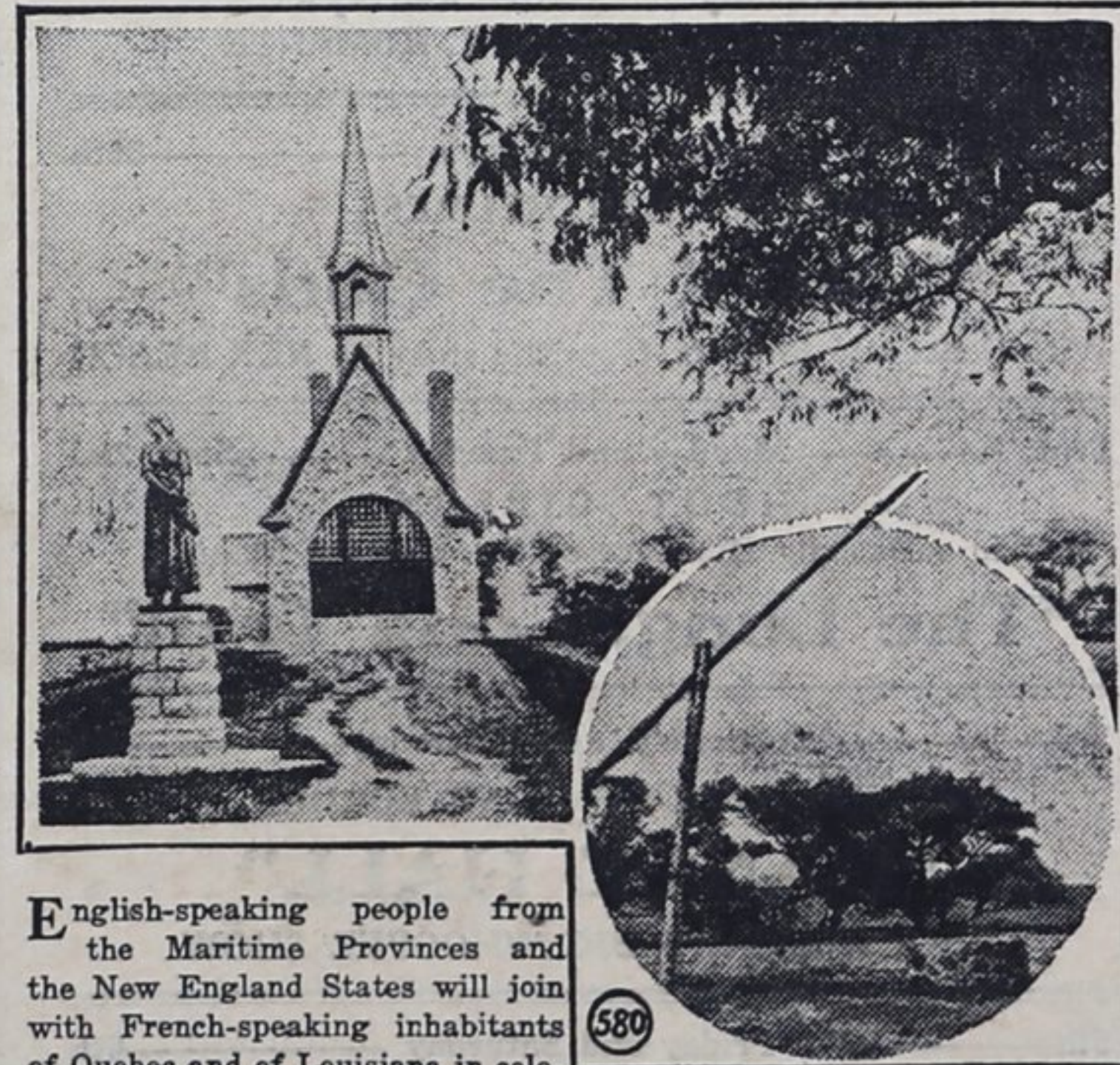


Very Concerned Lady (as glider passes overhead): "Young man, are you aware that you've lost your propeller?"

Invitations have been sent to the governments of Great Britain, France, the United States and Canada and also to the governors of Louisiana and Massachusetts to attend, while it is expected that the Lieutenant-Governor and Prime Minister of Nova Scotia will be present and will address the gathering.

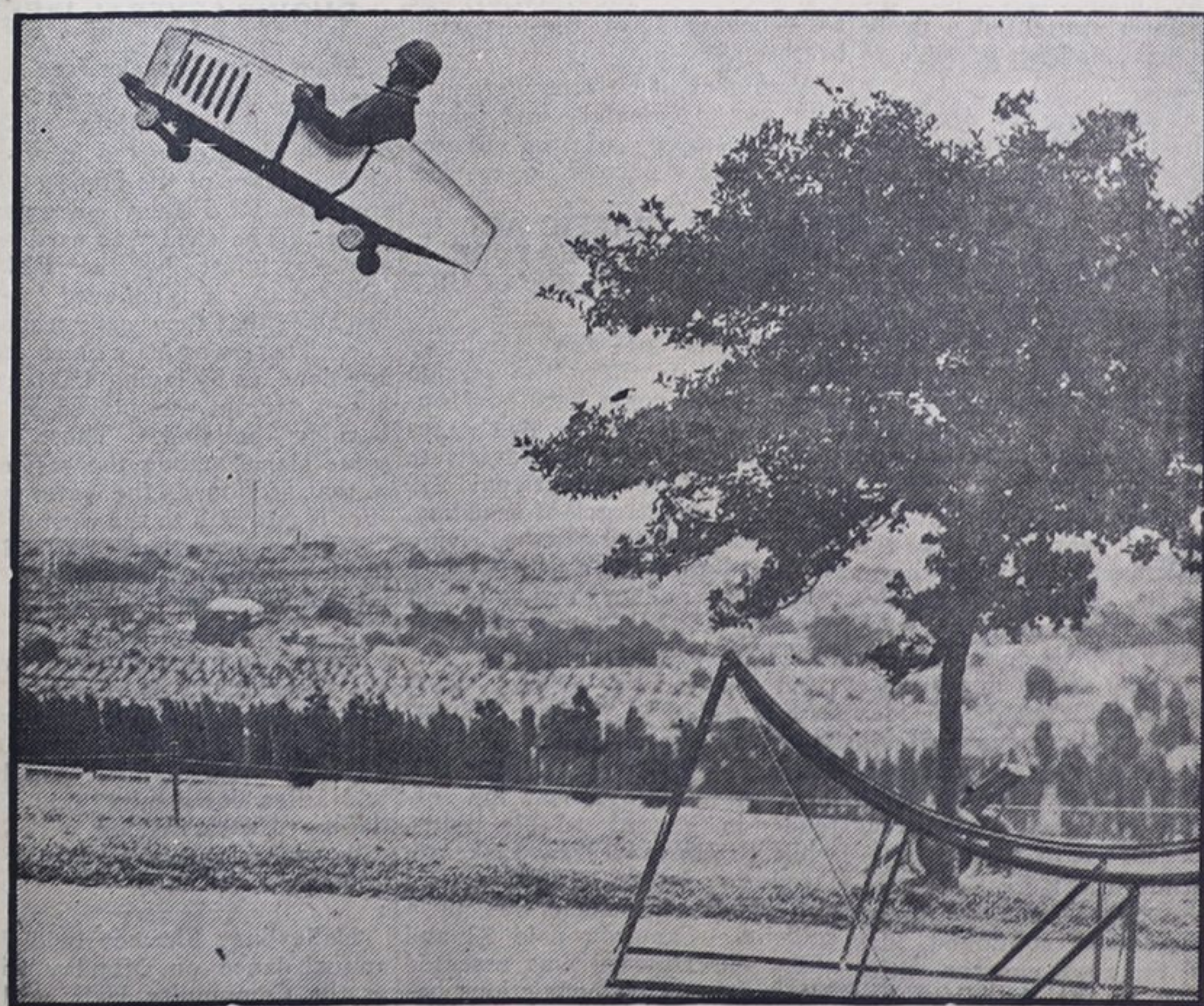
