While fear has a very decided action upon the human body, it is probable that the effects of fear caused by actual, definite situations such as that experienced when one narrowly escapes being run over by a motor car, are not as serious as those due to imaginary sources.

The world is full of people who are always worrying about something; they worry about their health, they fear the loss of their jobs or their money, they are unduly susceptible to the opinions of others, or they labor under a sense of guilt or shame because of some act they have committed.

Doubtless persons prone to such fears owe something to their hereditary make-up, but it is clear that many of them have been made so by the habits begun in childhood by parents, ignorant or thoughtless, or themselves also victims of unreasonable fears. Who does not know of the mother who magnifies her child's every pain or ache, who enlarges endlessly upon every slight misdeed with suggestions of devine wrath to come, who rushes to shield him from every conceivable contact with life, mixing in his quarrels and developing in him a sensitiveness to slights, real or imaginary, of which he himself might never be aware.

The best equipment for life that parents can give their children is not to dwarf their imagination but to direct it in healthful and constructive channels, to endow them with the ability to look the world squarely in the face and to accept with fortitude whatever may come their way. 
