

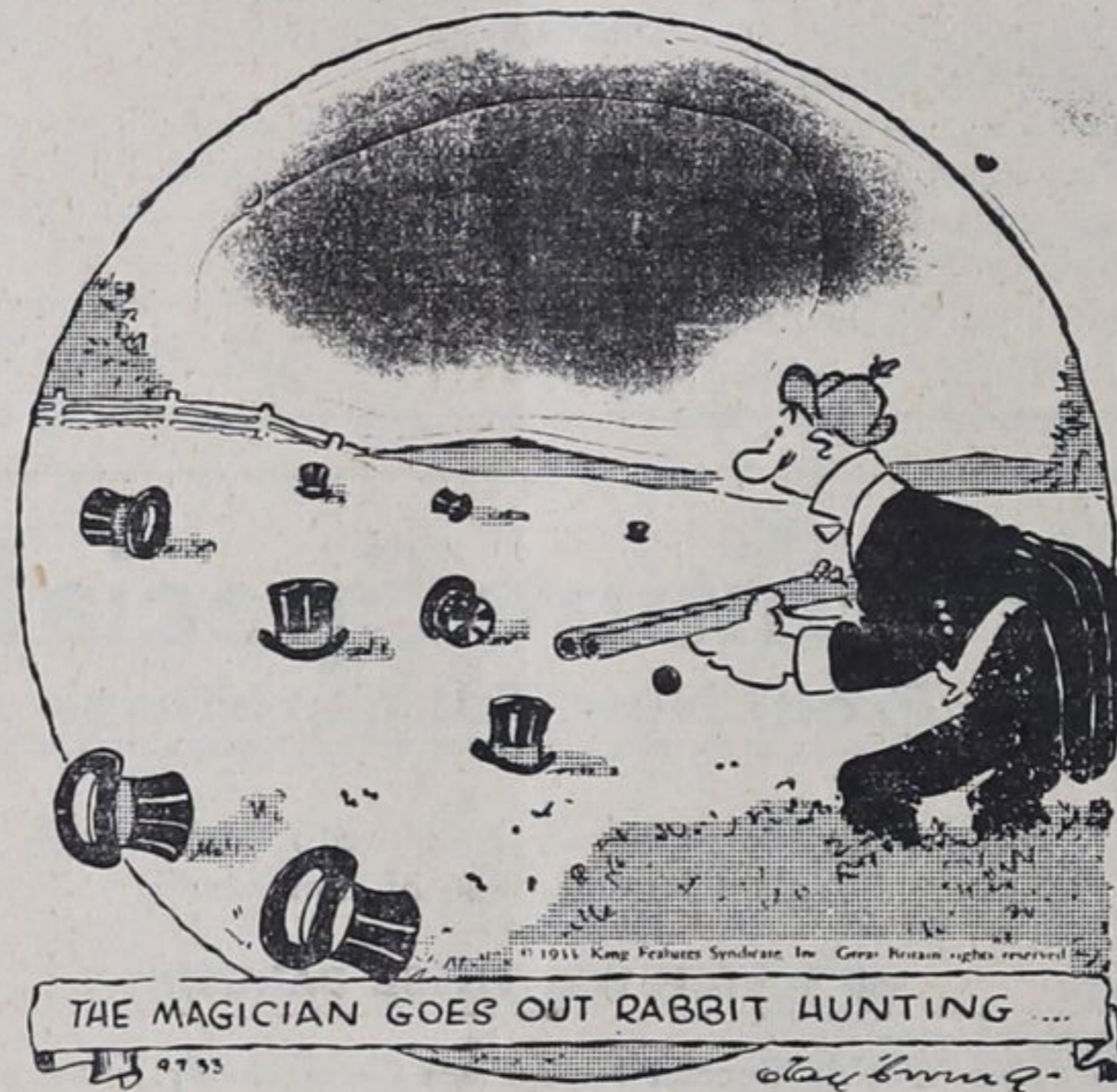

Two members of the Government forces helping a wounded companion after having taken the village of Arguis

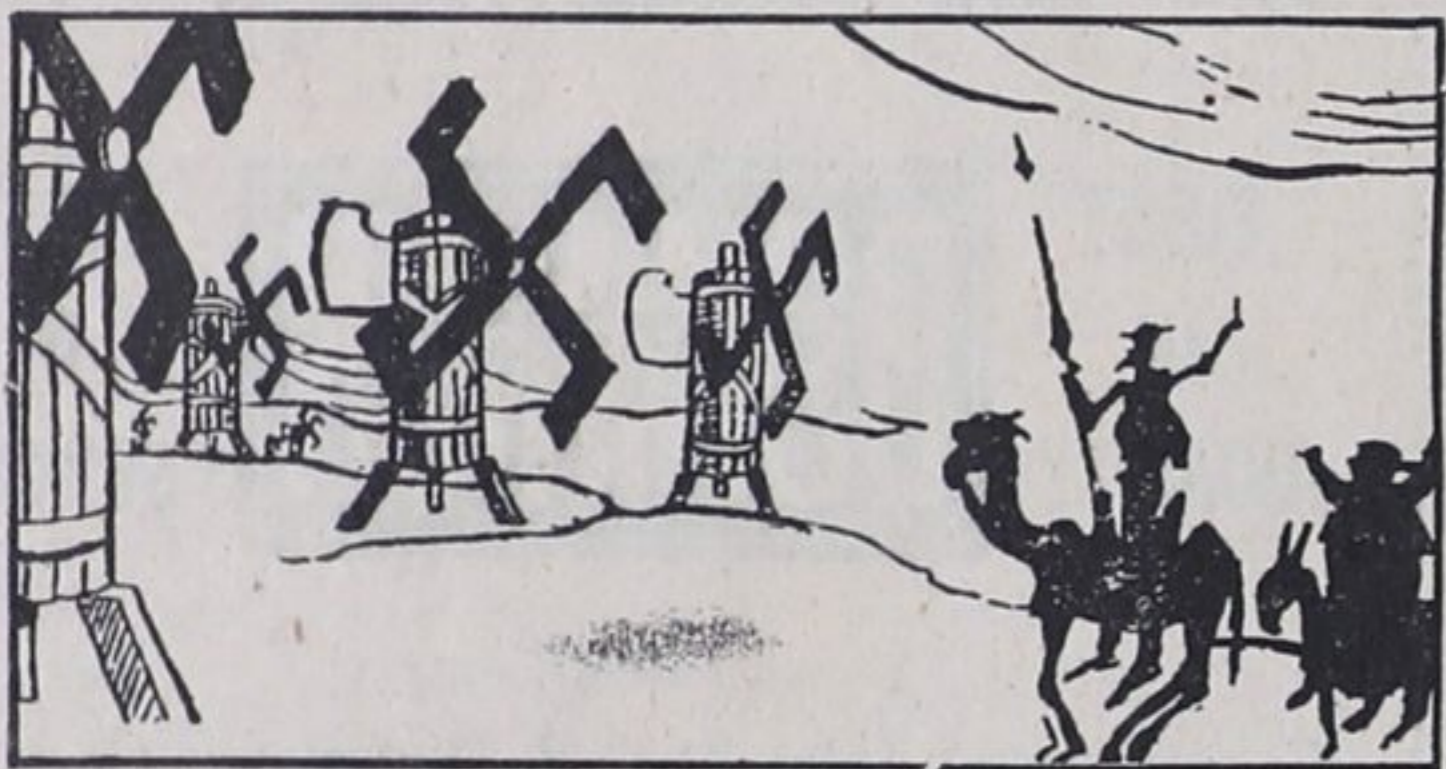

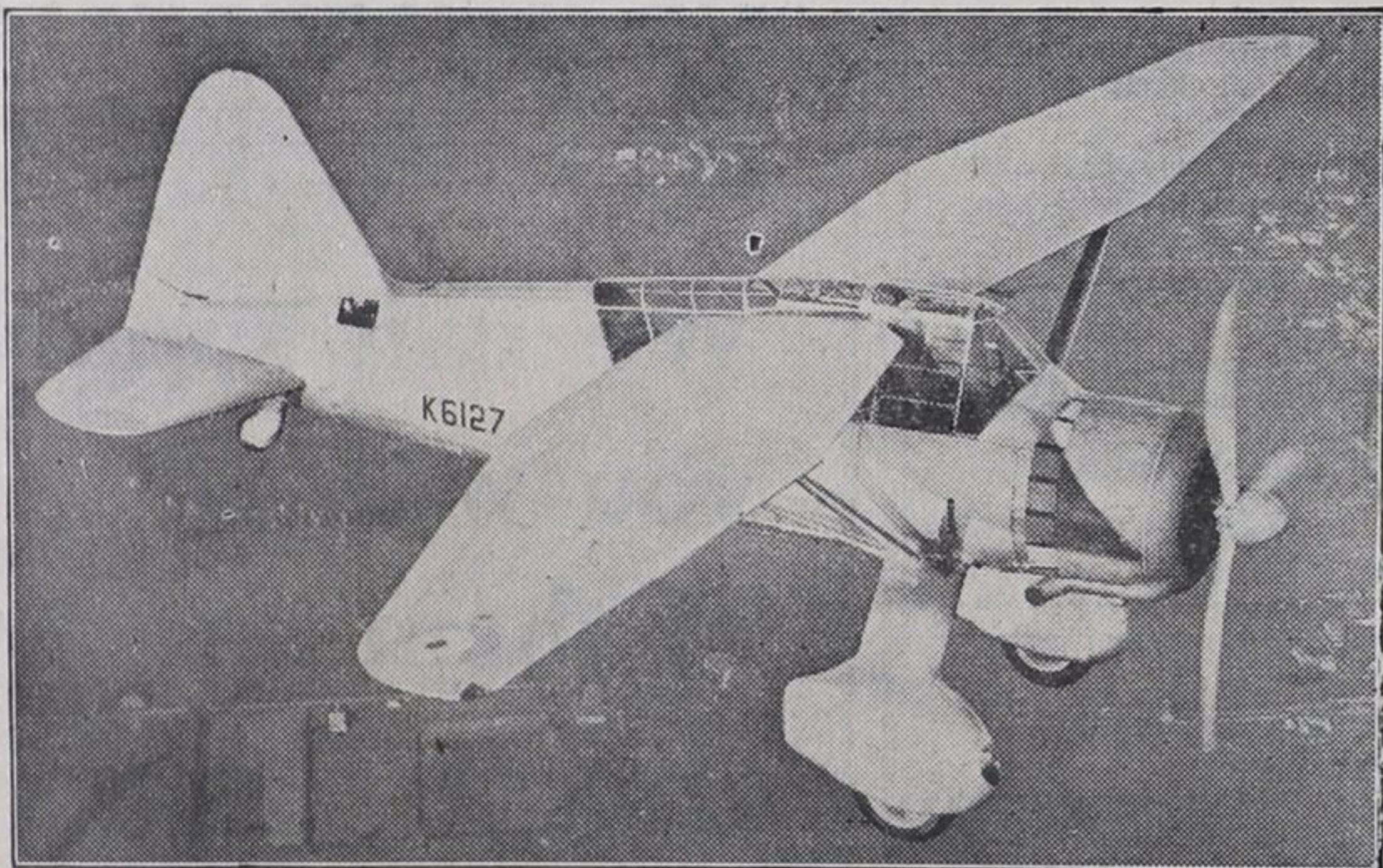


Cameramen ready for filming a scene of "The Navy Eternal" in which many of Britain's fighting vessels of several types took part.

NEW TYPE MONOPLANE FOR ROYAL AIR FORCE

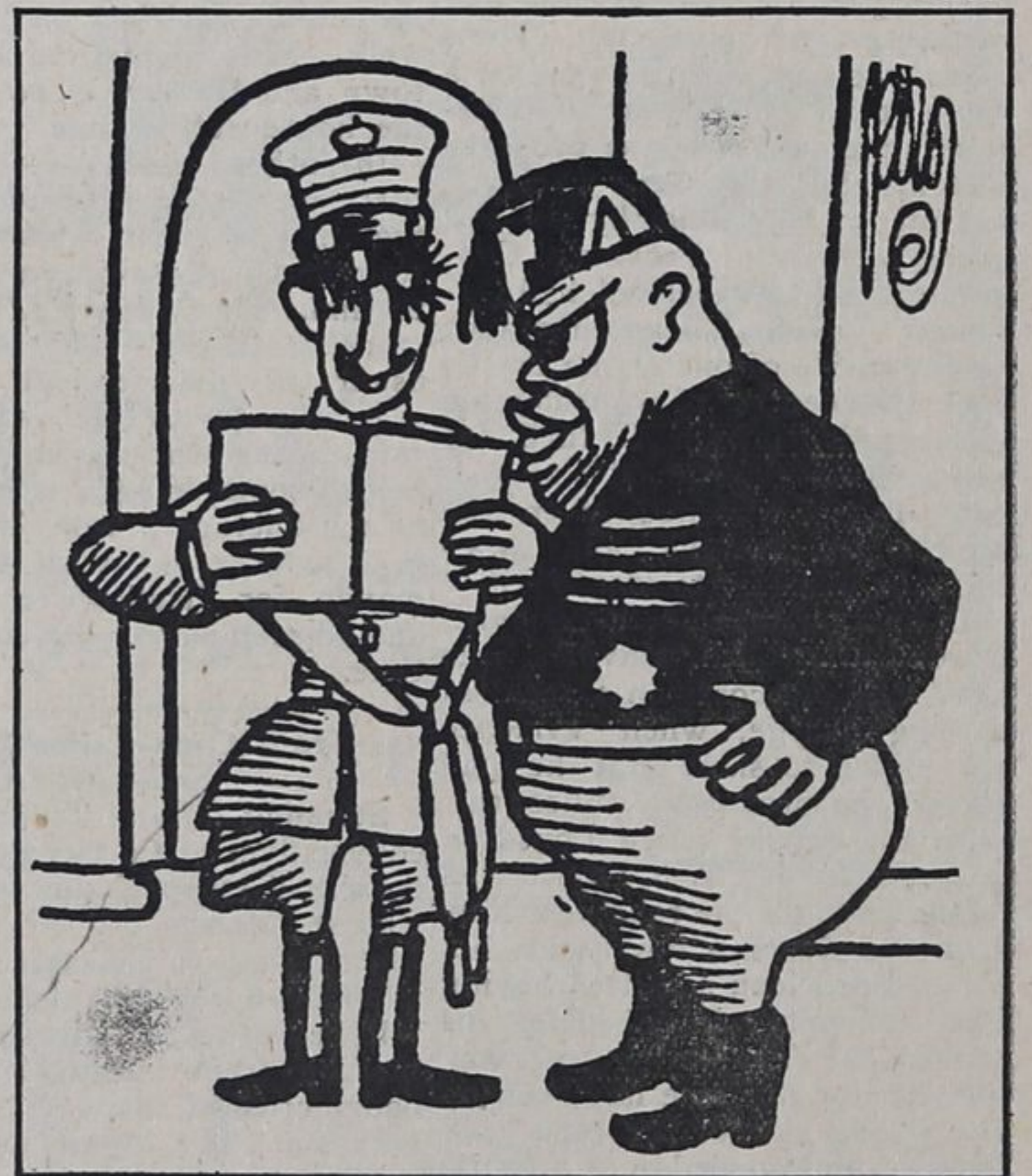


The "Westland Army Co-Operation Monoplane" of a new type, and capable of phenomenal speed which has not yet been disclosed, has been ordered in large numbers by the R.A.F.
