# Household Hints

Here's a suggestion: If you like tender steak but the old budget simply won't let you buy it, buy a beef heart, cut and cook in the manner suggested below. It amakes a good substitute.

Apple Crisp

Wash, pare, core and slice apples, put in greased baking dish. Add cinamon, water and 1/2 cup sugar. Mix remaining sugar with shortening and flour until mixture is crumbly. Sprinkle mixture over apples and bake in a moderate oven ( 375 degrees F.) for about 1 hour. Serve hot with cream, hard sauce or ice cream as topping.
