A letter was read from the Northern Ontario Natural Gas Co. Ltd. requesting the Council to pass the necessary by-law granting a franchise to the Company to supply the Town of Haileybury with natural gas.

Councillor Fleming thought that if the Town did so there should be a time limit set for the Company to commence operations. He did not believe in tying up the town for an indefinite period.

The Council took the view that considering the large amount of money the company was spending, if the passing of the franchise by-law would assist them there could be no harm in helping them, especially as the majority of the municipalities were doing the same things.
