The watt-hour meter that measures the electricity you use is made with the same precision as a fine watch. Sealed to withstand dust and moisture, its sapphire-jewelled bearings never need oil. It is designed to operate efficiently and accurately at all temperatures and is periodically -checked by Dominion Government Inspectors.

Electricity is metered in kilowatt-hours (1,000 watts used for one hour). The small dial; at the bottom of the meter illustrated measures 1/10th of a kilowatt-hour. On completion of one revolution, the dial at the right moves one unit to show one kilowatt-hour. Similarly, the three other dials indicate, from right to left, units of ten, one hundred and one thousand kilowatt-hoursyour meter, at all times maintains an accurate record of the small amount of low-cost electricity required to provide a better way of living.
