Many of these drownings ificial respiration were applied in time and for a sufficiently long period. There are records of people who have been in the water for half a hour, who have been brought back; others have been saved after more than four hours of working on them, although they were apparently drowned. Artificial respiration should be continued for hours, until a doctor positively certifies death or until rigor mortis sets in.

Classes in artificial respiration are available in most communities, either through St. John Ambulance Association, Red Cross or the local Civil Defence organization. This knowledge may save a life- it paysto learn.
