Oreamy French Dressing (Makes 1% cups)

teaspoon salt teaspoon dry mustard 3 tablespoons sugar

3 tablespoons catsup to sup undiluted evaporated


Eliminate tasks which you can such as washing walls, shades woodwork and drapes by using a vacuum cleaner attachment often enough.




















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
