the festivities put on yearly by the campers. These include the annual square dance, "Movie Night" when a movie of an English play depicting the "Murder that

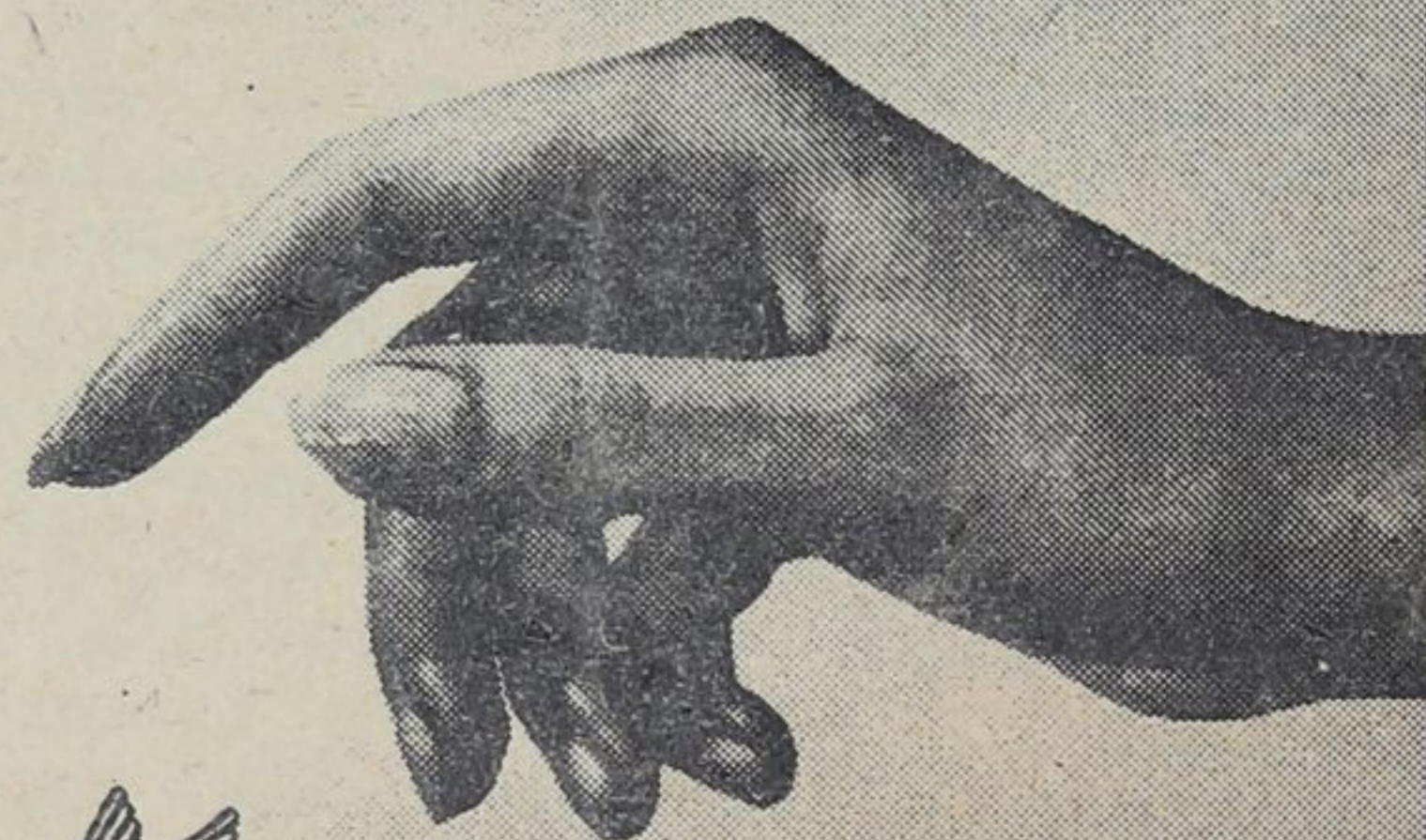
didn't Happen" and the annual play written and presented by the campers. Mr. McLean was particularly impressed by the impersonation of Elvis Presley,

which, he said was better than the original. Other numbers, including dancing and skits, were top quality.

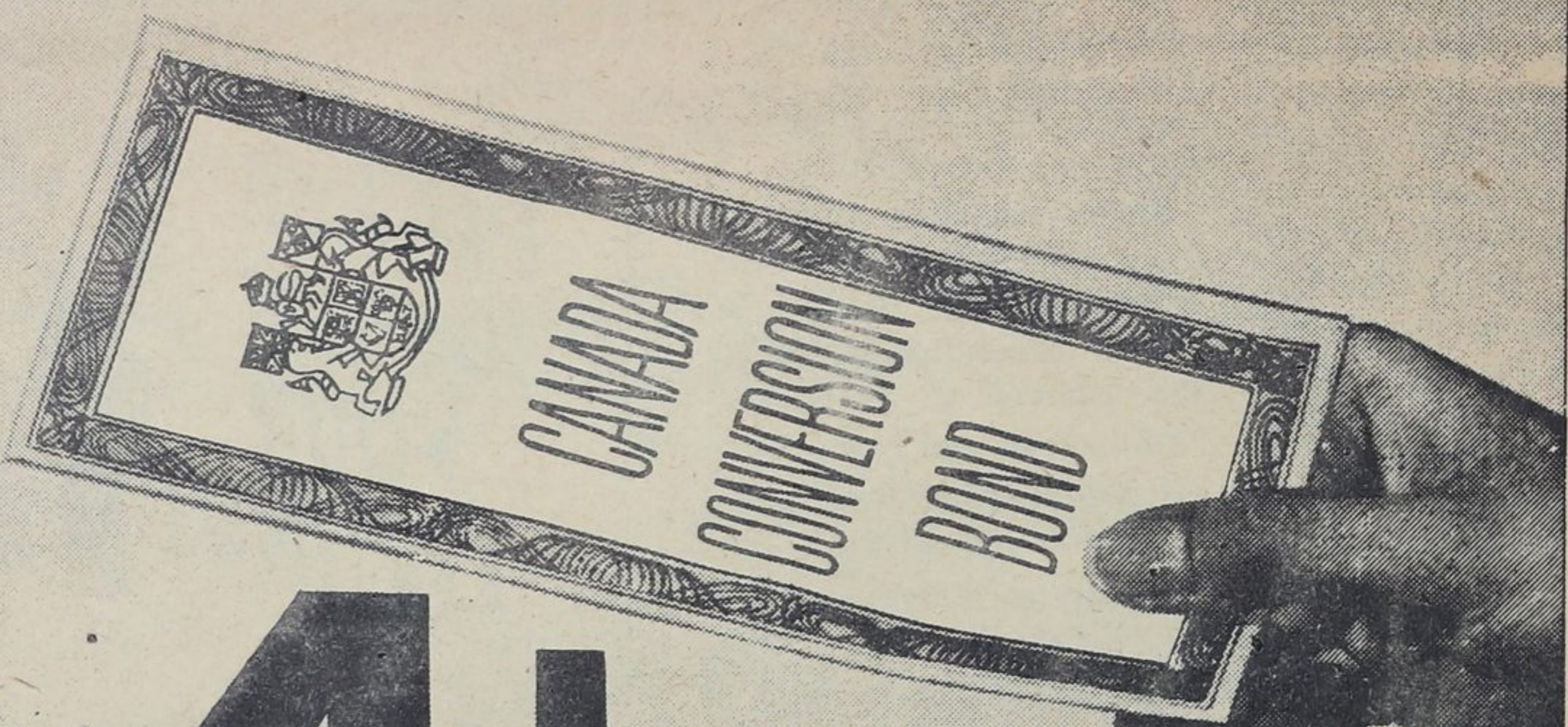
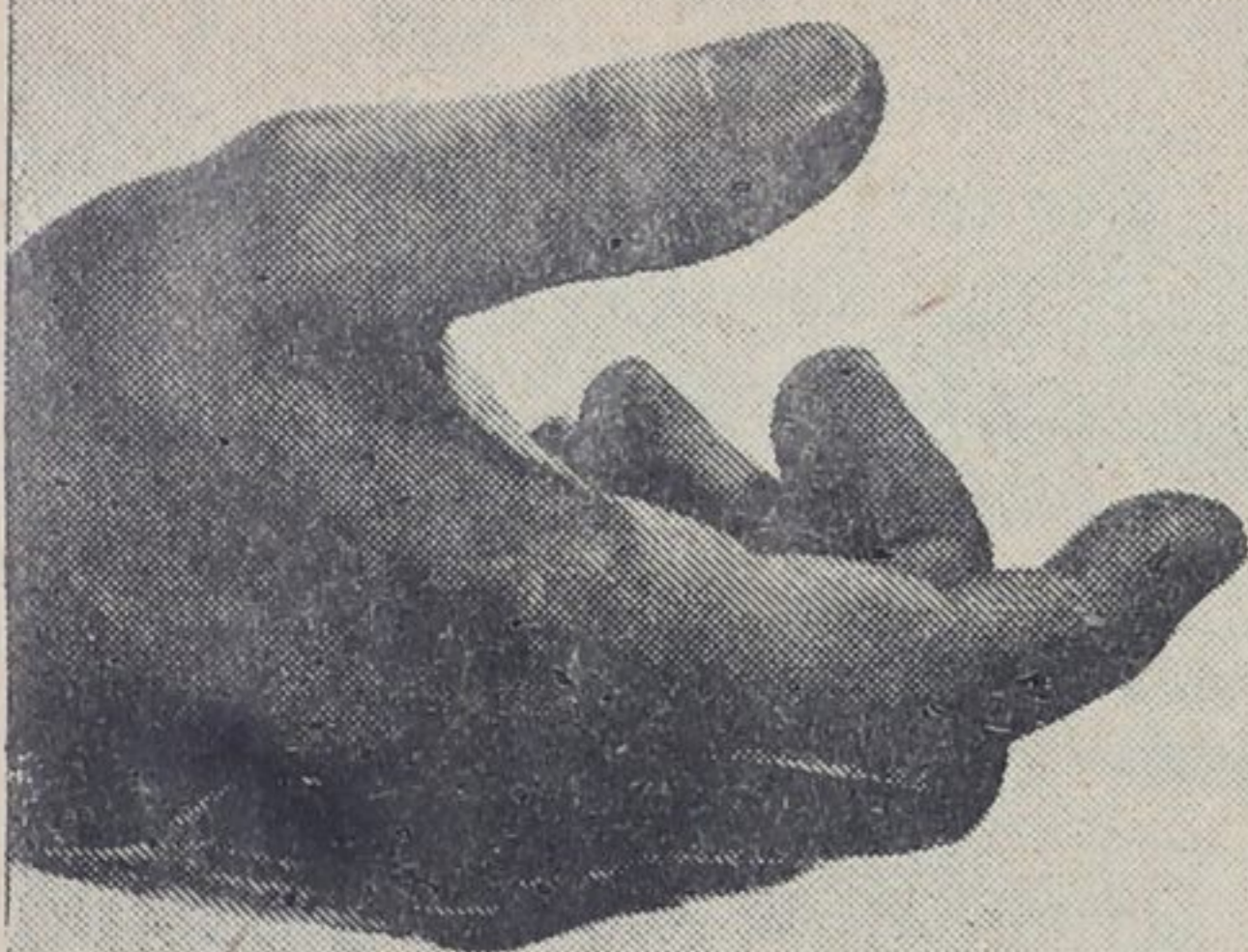
