CHURN DRILLING GETS PLACER-GOLD VALUES IN ANCIENT RIVER BEDS NEAR SUDBURY

In surface work, test-pitting and churn drilling over a wide area, the company has encountered placer-gold values which have economic possibilities.

As part of a stepped-up program, two churn drills have been working steadily since the first of the year on the company's approximate 2,280-acre placer-gold property in the Ross Lake area, near Capreol, Ontario. The pace of drilling is being maintained on a maximum effort basis in order to test as much yardage as possible before the Spring break-up.

The presence of gold has also been confirmed on Concor's approximate 4,040-acre property in the Meteor Lake area, about 40 miles north of Capreol. A broader exploratory program is planned for this group also.
