

Edward J. Atkinson

The death occurred in Misericordia Hospital, Haileybury, on Saturday, May 9, of Edward James Atkinson, following an illness of less than a year.

Mr. Atkinson was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Sigfried Atkinson, pioneer residents of Haileybury, and was born in East Bolton, Que.

He was actively engaged in construction work, along mining and hydro lines until his health failed. The nature of his work took him to many different places, among them Mexico, where he spent a number of years, Timmins, Baise Comeau, and many others. Previous to his illness, he had been for several years at Lavrieville, and was the representative of the H. G. Acres Company at Niagara Falls.

He is survived by his wife, the former Lillian Hosie, his parents,

Mr. and Mrs. S. Atkinson, and two sons, Edward James and Campbell William, both of Toronto. Also surviving are a brother, Cyril Atkinson of Toronto and a sister, Mrs. Thyra Fancy of Haileybury.

Mr. Atkinson rested at the home of his parents, Rorke Avenue until time for the funeral service which was held from St. Paul's Anglican Church, Monday afternoon at three o'clock. Rev. Roy Nixon officiated at the service.

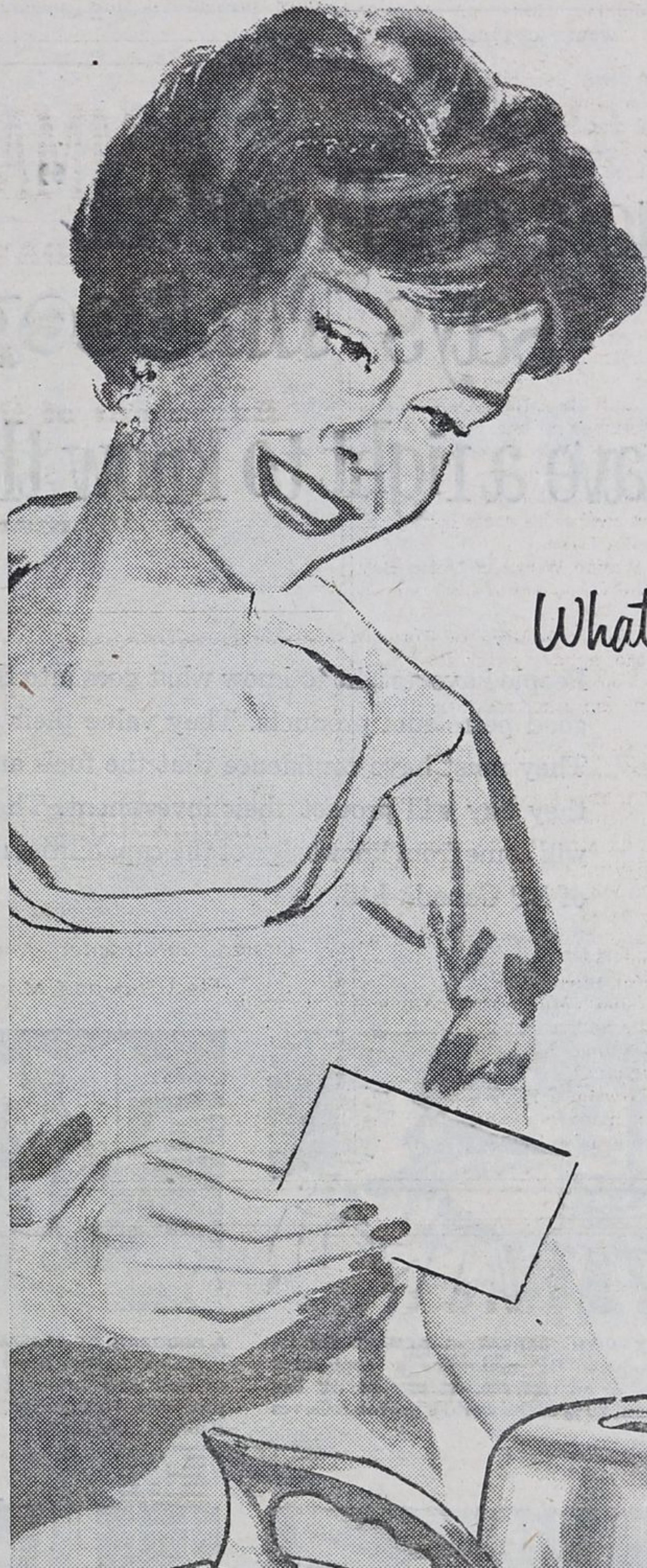

St. Paul's Anglican W.A. are holding a Garden Party and Tea at the Rectory on Saturday, June 20, 3 to 6 p.m.

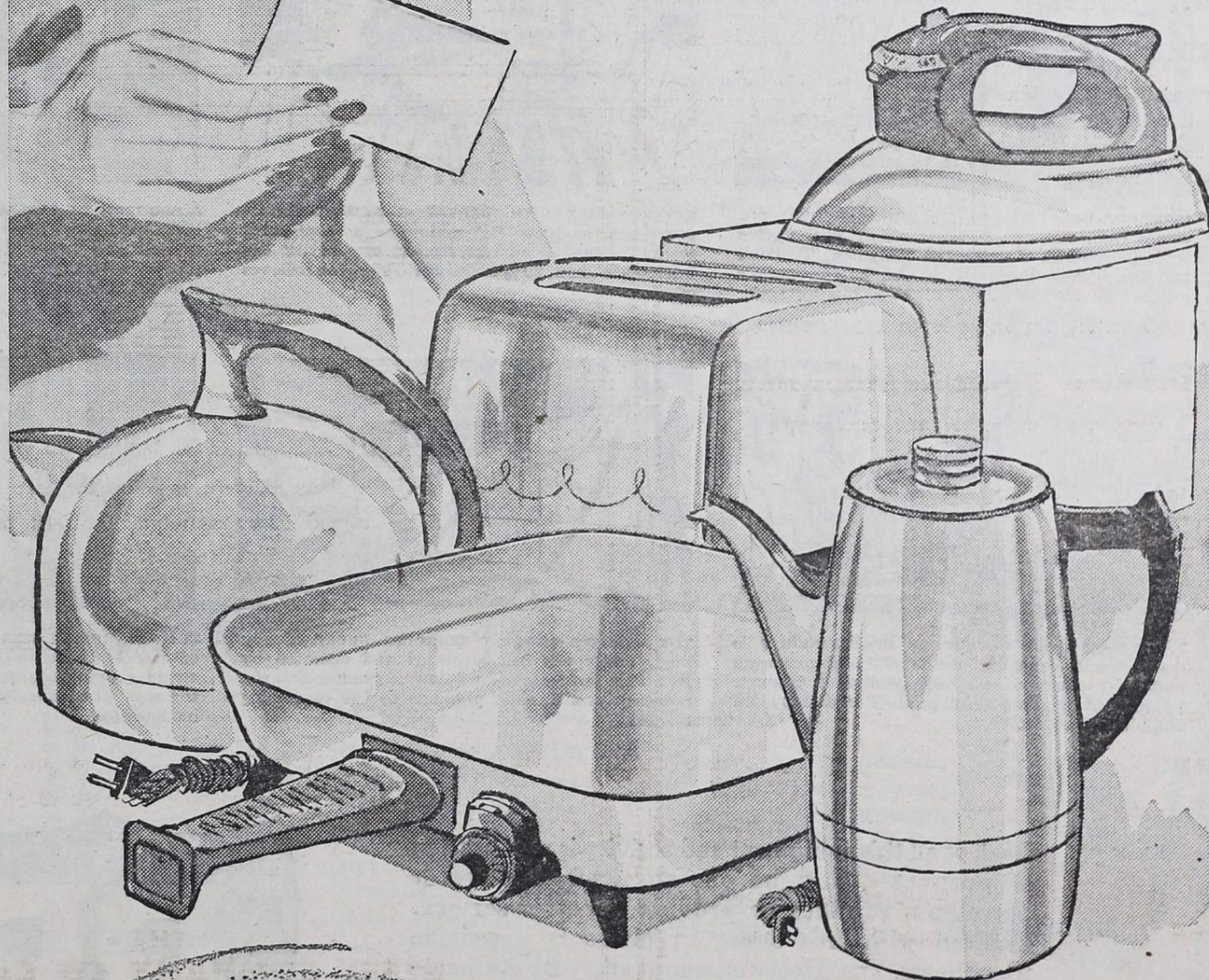
