Claim staking in Ontario continues to show a distinct upward trend. During the first six months of this year 14,138 claims were recorded as compared with 11,235 in the corresponding period of 1958.

Figures released by the Ontario Department of Mines show that altogether ten of the 14 divisions in the province have shown an

increase in the first half of this year over the same period in 1958, with most substantial gains being made in the Larder Lake, Porcupine and Sudbury mining divisions.

Additional interest has been shown recently in the iron deposit in Boston township, Larder Lake division, and there has been increased activity in the townships of Garrison, Harker, Lamplugh and Frecheville.

To the end of June, 6,775 miner's licenses had been issued or renewed as compared with 6,356 in the first six months of 1958.
