## Tips On Trimming Established Hedges

Hedges that run wild in the hot growing season need that extra trim to bring the home grounds out of the "jungle" category. And landscape specialists of the Ontario Department of Agriculture have worked on a few timely tips which might produce this change in the best interests of both gardener and garden.

Trimming an established hedge should be done at the time of its most rapid growth—and that time seems to be right about now. Other factors might include the species of hedge, rate of growth and the matter of convenience. Trimming of a long hedge should not be started unless it can be finished in one operation.

Hedge trimming is often one of the first spring projects. In many cases this is the only trimming during the year for an informal hedge. But rarely is this one cutting enough to keep a formal hedge in perfect condition. A second pruning will eliminate bulges at the top and brush heads which may result from earlier pruning. If possible, hedges should be trimmed during dull weather, otherwise the bright sunshine will burn the cut tips. Do not be too anxious to prune in autumn; the resulting new growth may be winter-injured.

Here are a few pointers on how to trim:

Use sharp tools so that the shoots are cut clean and not bruised. Use stakes and lines as guides for correct height and evenness. Clip the sides first—the cuttings from the top will then fall clear, and the desired height can be determined more easily.
