

Award Contest for Safety Suggestion

The Honourable The Attorney-General has announced that a substantial cash prize, to be known as the Jack Hammell Highway Safety Suggestion Award, will be presented to the person who submits in writing the best idea, or suggestion, on the subject of traffic safety, to the District Inspector of the Ontario Provincial Police in his or her respective District on or before December 10, 1959.

To be eligible each entry in this contest must be no more than 150 words in length, must clearly outline some concrete suggestions for

promoting highway traffic safety and must be received at the office of the District Inspector not later than 12 o'clock noon on Thursday, December 10, next. All mailed entries must be postmarked not later than 12 o'clock noon on Wednesday, December 9, 1959.

Submissions will be judged solely on the basis of merit and originality, following which a cash prize of \$50.00 will be awarded to the winner in each of the seventeen districts of the O.P.P. In addition a grand prize of \$150.00 will be presented to the person who submits the entry adjudged to contain the best idea from all seventeen districts.

Further advice will be forthcoming shortly on the method of judging this contest. In the meantime it is The Honourable Mr. Roberts' wish that you bring this matter at once to the notice of the Public in your area through the medium of the Press, Radio and Television.

This contest is created for the purpose of stimulating public interest in the ever-increasing problem of Highway Traffic Safety and it is imperative, therefore, that every effort be made to encourage citizens to participate.


