"In the Parry Sound Forest District, it is estimated that 9.9 million cubic feet of timber can be cut from Crown lands each year without depleting our timber resources," he points out. "However, on private lands which comprise 42 per cent of the area of this district, it is estimated that 47.6 million cubic feet of timber can be cut each year without depleting the timber resources. This means, of course, that owners of private. woodlands have a decided advantage when it comes to selling forest products to the many establisted mills in Muskoka and Parry Sound,
