Man Charged for Temagami Murder

Stanley Roy, 40-year-old Temagami trapper and guide was charged with the murder of his wife last week. Mrs. Roy, former Jane Friday, died in hospital at Haileybury Saturday, September 24, apparently the victim of a brutal beating.

An autopsy was conducted by Dr. J. R. Hall of North Bay, which revealed that she died

from brain injuries, apparently caused by blows to the head.

Inspector Ken Grice of the OPP criminal investigation bureau took charge of the investigation, and the charge of murder was laid Thursday on his instruction by Constable R. Hopkins of the Temagami Detachment.

Stanley Roy was detained for questioning, but later released.

Police were called on the evening of September 23 by a local taxi driver, allegedly because Roy wanted his wife driven to hospital.
