

"It might be well to point out that the Community Centre Board at one time offered the Cobalt town clerk \$100 to look after bookings at the community centre. The clerk returned the cheque and offered to do the work without pay. The next month he was relieved of his job and another person was hired to do this work.

"We are not critical of the manner in which the Board has operated in the past; they have done a good service to the community. However, in the course of time, ideas crop up that benefit the finances of the town, in this case 3 Community Centre Board.
