**Creamery Report**

During the year 1960 the District of Temiskaming produced a total of 1,109,168 pounds of creamery butter, the highest production coming in June with 170,079 pounds and July with 155,036. The lowest month was February with 31,272 pounds. The total number of pounds produced in Northern Ontario, which takes in Algoma, Cochrane, Kenora, Manitoulin, Nipissing, Rainy River, Sudbury and Thunder Bay, as well as Temiskaming, was 3,214,883 with Temiskaming producing over one-third of the total amount.

Temiskaming's total production of Cheddar cheese for the year was 383,637 pounds. Rainy River was the only other Northern Ontario district to produce cheese, with a total of 950 pounds.
