Northern Rotarians Hear International President

About 100 Rotarians from many Rotary Clubs in Northeastern Ontario and Northwestern Quebec, gathered at Englehart last Friday. They met to hear an address by Nitish C. Laharry of Calcutta, president-elect of Rotary International.

The president-elect referred to the international aspects of Rotary, which was established by Paul Harris, an American, and has spread to 123 countries. "Rotary's specific contribution is that it has made the approach to our ideal—a realistic one, by attempting to correlate it to the needs of modern man and modern society through its four avenues of service."

Since "the profit motive in man cannot be rooted out from human nature . . . let us make all the profit we can, but in doing so let the basis of that profit be service." Mr. Laharry claimed that "Rotary has the right perspective to world affairs and that Rotarians are fully equipped to be in the front line of this battle royal between idealism and materialism."

He urged the men to build up fellowship among themselves, through their vocations and community ties and through the world.

In a thought-provoking address, "Rotary in a world of challenge," the guest traced present world difficulties and their causes. He blamed the Darwin theory, the "philosophy of negativism discovered by Huxley and his companions, Marxism, atom bombs, hydrogen bombs, space rockets and the explosive nature of world population."

Mr. Laharry offered one solution.

"We all need to become revo-

lutionaries. Undoubtedly man cannot live without bread, but can he live with bread alone? Materialistic revolution will never solve moral or spiritual problems," he said.

"There is no special form of business morality which is different from the morality which rules the rest of life. The phrase 'business is business' is just a cloak for hiding irresponsible and un-social practices which do not spell business but the death of all business."

Mr. Laharry affirmed "that man has lost his soul, but I am equally sure that man can find and must find his soul again by endeavoring at all times not to let the end of life be forgotten in our preoccupation with the means of living."

"Peace," he said, "begins in the minds of men. No effort should be spared to take this message even to our remotest villages and convince every man, woman and child that a warless world is only possible if each one of us is determined that 'nation shall no longer lift sword against nation'."

The speaker concluded with his conviction that individuals "can lay the foundations of a solid and substantial world structure, with the individual human being as its core. The path is narrow and steep and the problems bristle with challenges to each of us."

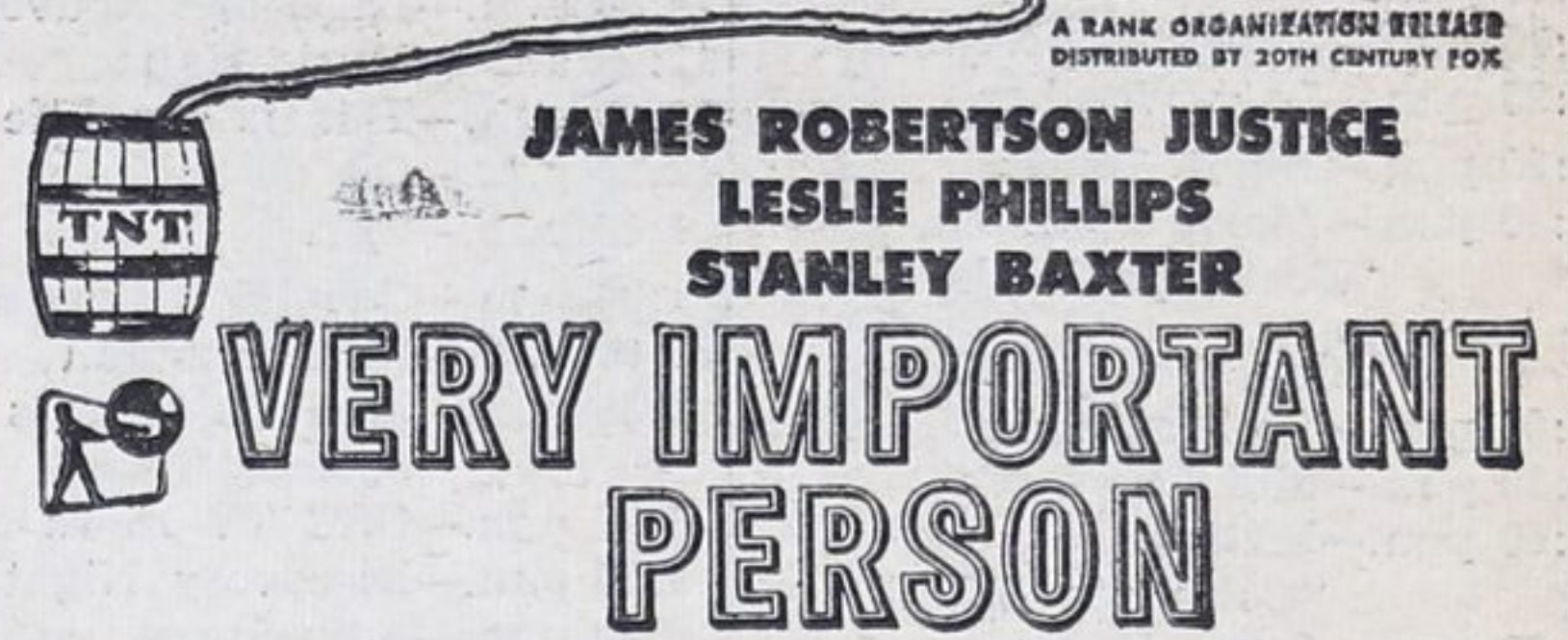
