Silver Rebekahs 50th Anniversary

One of the pioneer Lodges of the North, the Silver Rebekah Lodge No. 107, Cobalt, marked its 50th anniversary last Friday.

Some 150 members and members of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows gathered in the IOOF Hall to celebrate the event.

The organization was established on October 17, 1911, when the charter meeting was held in the then-Odd Fellow's Hall on Silver Street. Early meetings were held as well on Argentite Street over the Rodd and Deacon's Store as well as at 22 Lang Street, which was owned by the Jamieson Meat Company.

This latter building, presently in use, was finally bought by the Cobalt Lodge No. 379 and the place is filled with "pleasant memories" of the many years of activity.

Four charter members were present, only one of whom holds continuous membership in the local lodge. She is Mrs. Ellen Bishop, New Liskeard.

With her were charter members Mrs. Ness McAulay, Haileybury; Miss Florence McLaughlin, Timmins; and Mrs. Janet Sykes, who came all the way from Detroit, Michigan, to be present at the 50th anniversary celebrations.

Among the key executives on hand for the event, too, were Mrs. May Bennetts, Kirkland Lake, district deputy president; Mrs. Eric Greening, Cobalt, Noble Grand; Charles Byam, New Liskeard, Past Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Ontario and a member of the New Liskeard Lodge No. 352; Mrs. Eula Hickie, Kirkland Lake, vice-president of the Rebekah Assembly of Ontario and Mrs. Stella Watson, South Temiskaming, Quebec, district deputy president of Nipissing District No. 36.

The 50th anniversary celebrations, complete with an appropriately decorated cake, were attended from out of town by members of Rebekah organizations at South Temiskaming, North Bay, Haileybury, New Liskeard, Englehart, Kirkland Lake and Timmins.

To date, about 517 men and women have received the Rebekah Degree locally and the present membership stands at 100. The lodge has made many contributions to local community welfare through the years.

Among the prominents at charter night 50 years ago were Ida G. Moore, who conducted the institution ceremony. She was assisted then by E. M. Chapman of the Hazel Lodge, Ottawa; Anne Jacobson, Excelsior Lodge, Montreal,

and a Miss Yaphic of the same lodge.

Mr. Byam, 57 years with the New Liskeard Lodge, said there are some 35,000 Rebekah members across Ontario and 32,000 Odd Fellows.

The program included the historical reading by Mrs. Pearl Brown, a solo by Miss Hilda Parcher accompanied by the piano by Mrs. Nora Neddo, a rendition of songs by the New Liskeard Barker Trio, community singing, a solo by Mrs. Helmut Wipprecht and a hilarious skit with the 50th anniversary as the main theme.

Ladies of the Friendship Group of the United Church catered to 150 guests at a luncheon which wound up the evening activities.
