## Students learn 'Lungs are for Life'

As municipalities across Ontario adopt bylaws to restrict smoking in restaurants, bars and other public places, the Lung Association in Halton Region is also working to prevent young people from ever starting to smoke.

The Lung Association's Lungs Are For Life school program teaches students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 that the majority of people don't smoke and that avoiding the temptation to try smoking will result in a far higher quality of life.

"We know the best way to keep our young people healthy today and in the years to come is to help them avoid the temptation of lighting up that first cigarette," says Dr. Roger Haddon, medical advisor.

"Smoking is the number one cause of preventable death and of lung disease.


The Lungs Are For Life school program is offered to all schools in Halton Region.
