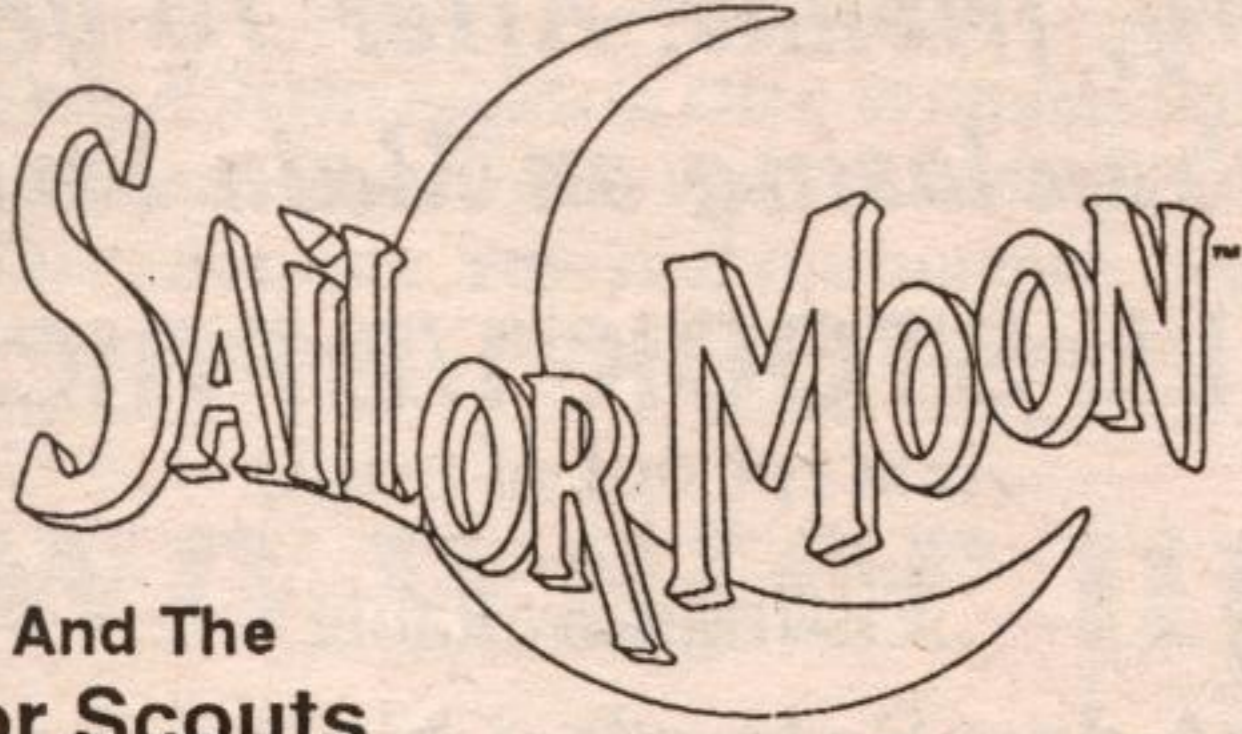

## Standard Products workers affected by GM strike

Management and staff at a Georgetown trim plant kept a close eye on the Canadian Auto Workers strike against General Motors, the country's largest auto maker.

In excess of 200 workers at Standard Products' Georgetown division have been on temporary layoff since Oct. 4, two days after the CAW strike against GM began.

More than 33,000 workers are off the job in Canada and the United States because of the strike.

The Georgetown plant is a major supplier of weather stripping to GM Oshawa – the car company is Standard's biggest customer.

Approximately 150 workers remain on the job in Georgetown, manufacturing weather stripping for Ford and other outside sources.

Plant secretary Janice Deoliveira said that the Georgetown plant could be back to full operation within days of ratification of any deal.

## Town wants talks with Board over school plans

Town councillors are not impressed with the Halton Board of Education's proposed plans to close schools and sell surplus land – especially plans to close and sell either Limehouse or Glen Williams Public School.

Selling the vacant Wrigglesworth and Speyside schools and closing either Glen Williams or Limehouse are options being considered by the Board as it attempts to

cut \$2 million from its budget.

Town staff note that while closure of either school will have a nominal impact on Town recreation programs, area residents will feel the potential loss of the campus facilities, including play equipment, minor playing fields and open space.

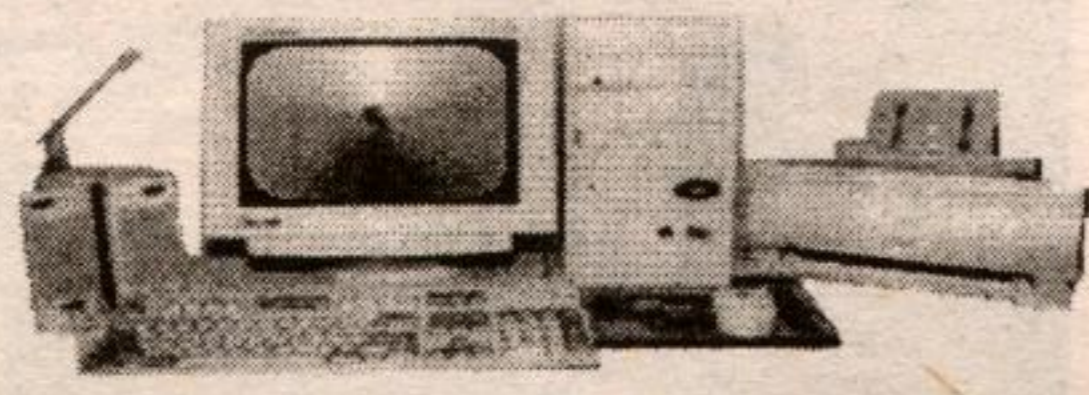
Town staff note that the Board has made its plans in isolation of the broader impact on the community and

suggest that an inter-departmental working group be set up to discuss the Board's plan and initiate on-going discussions and communication with the Board.

Ward 2 Councillor Kevin Kuiack said if the two schools are on the recommended list of closures, then the Town better send a strong message to the Halton Board of Education that it is affecting the rural community.
