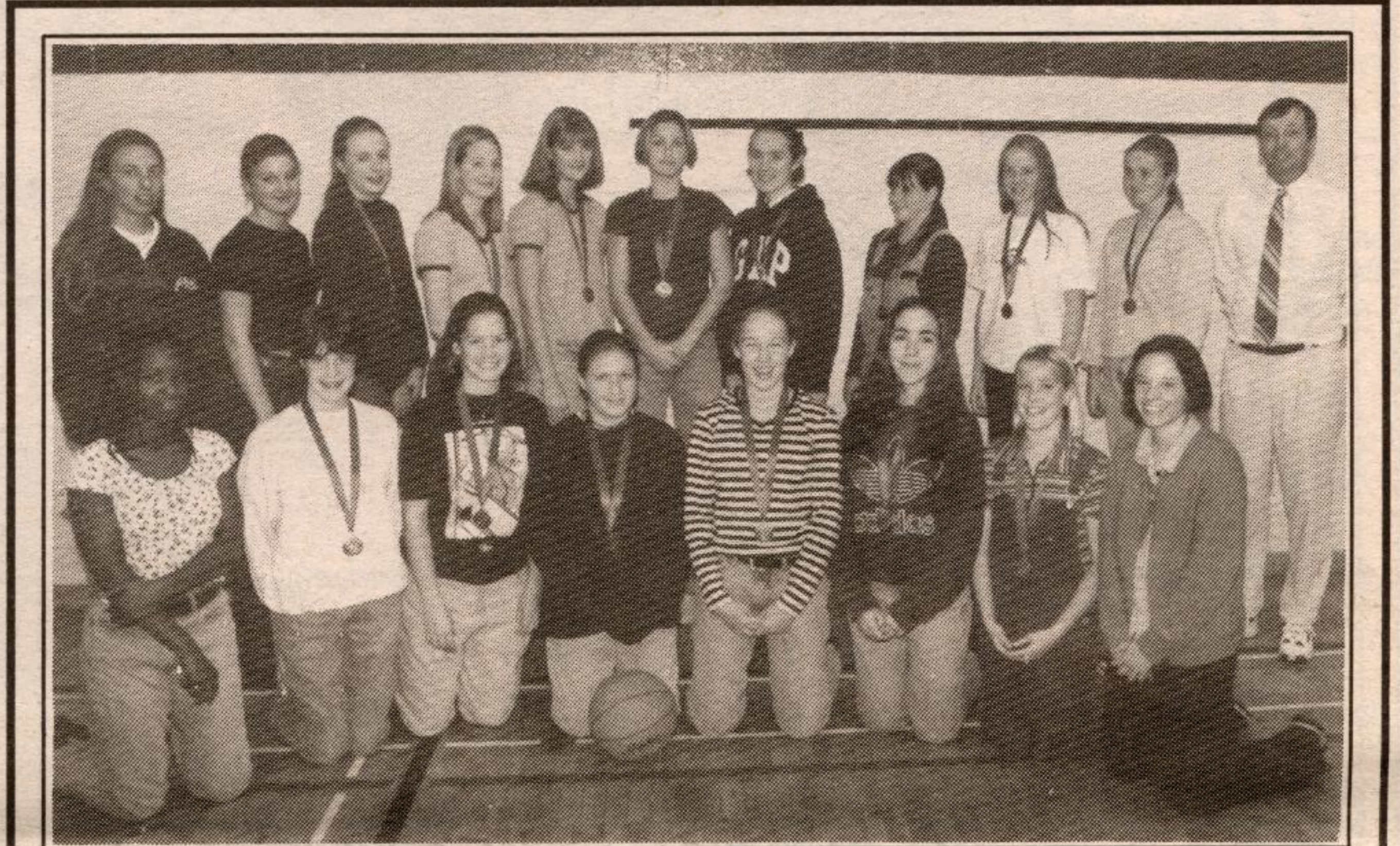

The Halton (Bars) League had Charley's almost reeling with a minor shock. Charley's average score going into the match was 11-3. Bracky's




**CHAMPIONS!** The Georgetown District High School Midget Girls Basketball Rebels were recently crowned as champions. (Jamie Harrison photo)
