### How to winterize your home

Last year's record breaking cold weather, massive snowfalls and never-ending winter storms caught many homeowners unprepared and with many unexpected and expensive repairs. Here are a few tips that can help battle the winter chill and keep costs down.

\*Check windows, door frames and baseboards for escaping heat by holding a lit match by gaps. If the flame moves or blows out you have a draft problem.

\*Use a white silicone caulking around doors and windows. (Spray foam is more effective for larger drafty cavities such as pipe outlets.) \*Replace worn or damaged weather-stripping around door and window frames. Most weather-stripping products only last a few years.


\*Clear plastic film can also be applied over windows using a hair dryer to stop drafts and prevent frost buildup as a temporary measure.

\*Good insulation goes hand

in hand with good ventilation, so check that your home's soffit (intake vent) androof (outtake) vents are in good condition and you have enough vent outlets. \*Expandable polyurethane foam products are the biggest selling insulation prod-

uct and can be used around dryer vents, television cable jacks, and other utility service entry points. \*Be aware that a little foam

goes a long way, so be careful not to overuse.
