The list of activities and organizations that Williams has been involved with is long and extensive and demonstrates the true spirit that the Lions Club looks for when presenting this award.

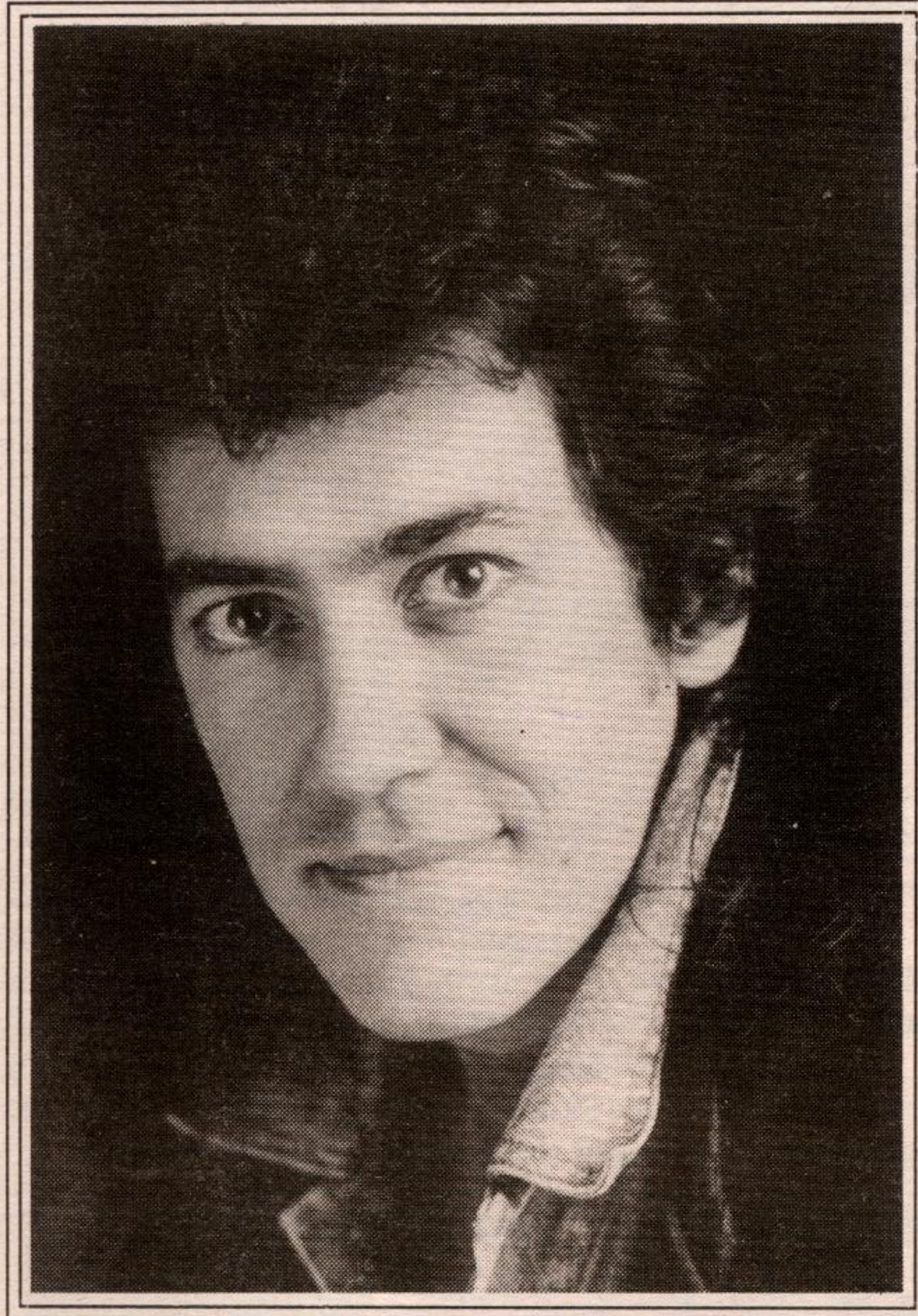

The officer stopped the vehicle as it traveled northbound on Trafalgar Road near 22nd Sideroad.

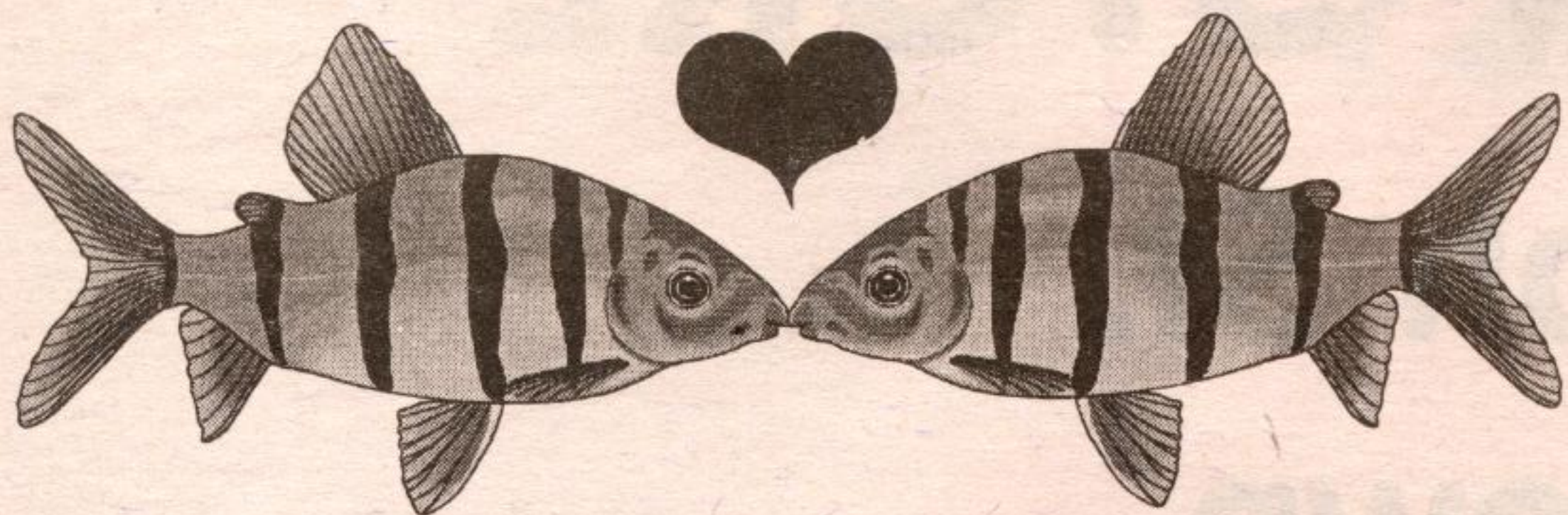
