Acton Council. After a long rest, the Village Council met for business last Thursday evening. All the members were present.

The minutes of last meeting (in June) were read and adopted.

Mr. Christie, chairman of the Streets and Side-walk committee, submitted the 4th report, recommending the payment of the following accounts for labor and material: C. T. Hill, for masonry, \$9.68; Brown & Hall, for lumber, \$9.73; S. Zimmerman, for laying sidewalk and crossings, \$24.50; for drawing gravel, \$9.37; repairing bridge, etc., \$1.50; culvert and grading on Elgin street, \$16.40; for lumber, \$15.75; sundry repairs \$5.75—being a total of \$92.29.

On motion of Mr. Christie, seconded by Mr. Nicklin, the report was adopted.

Mr. Henderson, chairman of Finance committee, presented the 7th report, submitting the following estimates of receipts and expenditures for the current year:

On motion of Mr. Henderson, seconded by Mr. Smith, the report was adopted.

Moved by Mr. Christie, seconded by Mr. Nicklin, that leave be granted to introduce a By-law to provide for support of the public school of Acton School Division for the current year, and that said By-law be read a first time.

Moved by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Henderson, that leave be granted to introduce a By-law to levy a rate on the assessable property of the village of Acton for the current year, and that said By-law be read a first time.

The Finance committee reported the following accounts, and recommended payment of the same: J. H. Hacking, printing, \$10; the Receiver, Clerk and Collector, for selecting jurors, \$3; J.

C. Hill, stationery, \$1.47; C. T. Hill, masonry, \$9.68; Brown & Hall, lumber, \$9.73; A. McNab, cutting thistles, \$1; John Stephens, removing stones, \$1; J. P. Allan, drawing stones, 75c; S. Zimmerman, lumber and laying sidewalks, \$27.12—being a total of \$115.75.

On motion of Mr. Henderson, seconded by C. S. Smith, the 8th report of Finance committee was adopted.

On motion of the By-law for the support of the public school was read a second time, and the Council went into committee of the whole to fill up the blanks—Mr. Nicklin in the chair.

The sum of \$1,400 was adopted for school purposes. The equalized assessment of the School Division is \$203,275—the rural portion being \$55,390, and the Village portion \$147,885. It was estimated that a levy of seven mills on the dollar on the total assessment would raise the required sum.

The By-law was finally passed, levying a rate of seven mills on the dollar.

On motion of Mr. Christie, seconded by Mr. Nicklin, leave was granted to introduce a By-law at next meeting of Council for the appointment of a Collector for the current year.

The following communication, addressed to the Receiver, was read for the consideration of the Council: Toronto, Sept. 29th.

Dear Sir: As I am soon going to vacate the Acton Township, I am looking out for a successor, but I have not yet heard of any one who would undertake so large a concern.

It was carried on as in my report, and I do not think that the village would grant a bonus to a tenant, say \$250, for not less than 20 acres of improved land, for every 1000 acres up to 2000 acres. If I could advertise this I think I could obtain a tenant in three or four weeks. If you think favorably of it, would you interest yourself to get the authorities to pass such a By-law. The taxes on the land in the township would be paid by the tenant, and I should be glad to hear from you on the subject, and if any movement is made to do it, it should be done at once.

G. L. BEARDMORE.

Mr. Christie stated his approval in general of the report of the Receiver, and recommended that the Receiver be authorized to manufacture to locate amongst us, but in the case under consideration he did not believe it would be wisdom on the part of the Council to do so.

He considered that if a bonus were given in this case, it would be tantamount to presenting the money to Mr. Beardmore, as he would as a matter of fact realize the benefit of it in being able to make a better disposition of his property.

The Receiver and Mr. Henderson both expressed themselves in somewhat similar terms, and no action was taken in the matter further than to instruct the Clerk to inform Mr. Beardmore of the views of the Council.

Mr. Christie introduced the subject of the great need of something being done towards procuring a site for a new cemetery. He referred to the dilapidated condition of the burying ground at present in use within the corporation, and the intention of the Council to occur from continuing to inter the dead in so close proximity to the centre of the village. He thought some action should be taken in the matter with as little delay as possible.

After some further conversation the Council adjourned. A meeting will be held this evening, for the purpose of appointing a Collector, and other business.

And whereas, through alteration being made to the Common Gaol of the County of Halton, in our said Province, and from other causes the said Gaol has become temporarily insecure and unfit for the safe-keeping of prisoners, and it has been determined by Our said Governor-in-Council that this Proclamation should be issued in accordance with the terms of the said Act in order to make provision therefor:
