TRADES.

At present the whole country is swarming with these, perhaps the most miserable of human beings—the tramp. Our Village is receiving her full share of them, as some days there has been seen as many as half-a-dozen to a dozen in one day, wandering around and begging. They will not work to earn a meal, but prefer begging to working. Some of them we believe, are objects on which to bestow charity, while others are lazy, good-for-nothing loafers, who go around from place to place imposing on those who they think are foolish enough to give them anything. This class are fit subjects for the Central Prison, to which place they should be sent for six months or year, and made to work for their living.

The tramps who have visited us are not entirely confined to the male class, but there is to me a number of females, who, perhaps, are the most uncivil and vicious of the whole tramp tribe. For instance, a woman called at this office one day last week and wished to know "if we would be kind enough to give her a little money to assist in taking her to Toronto." On being directed to the Reverend who has money for that purpose, she mildly told us that "we could keep our money and go to him." This same person went to different parishes and begged money to take her to Toronto, Guelph, and about a dozen other places.

Perhaps one of the best things that the new Council could do would be to erect a lockup in which to lodge tramps, and make them pay for their night's lodging by breaking Corporation stones which to grade our streets. The plea may be raised by some that it is up to us to provide for the tramps. So much the better. The more tramps here are lodged the more stones will be broken, and the better will be the streets. In a short time the tramps will earn nearly enough to pay for the lockup, which would not cost over \$500 or \$700 to the Village, as there are \$100 lying in Mites to be appropriated for that purpose, which was granted by the County Council. This money would erect a substantial lockup, with a Goliath Chamber above, and would be quite an ornament to our Village.

We hope the matter will be fully discussed at the next meeting of the Council, and we would like to see a substantial lockup erected in this Village in a short time.

THE BUSINESS OF FLOCK
FOR 1878.

Judging from present appearances, the business prospects for the year upon which we have just entered are by no means encouraging. There is an abundance of money in the country, but there is nothing to bring it into circulation. Farmers in this section of the country do not seem at all inclined to sell their grain at present, although the prices paid are good. No doubt the cause of their holding their grain is because they anticipate England's going into war against Russia, very soon, when it least will take a sudden turn. Therefore, as the farmers do not sell their grain, it tends to make the money market pretty close. If they would bring their grain into the market and sell it, it would put an immense amount of money into circulation; but as they do not seem inclined to do so just now, things look pretty bleak for at least the next six months.

In view of these facts, business men would do well to proceed cautiously. Merchants should purchase sparingly; manufacturers should also curtail their operations to the manufacture of such staple articles as cannot well be done without; and all should live it down. They should be a

general taking in of sail, and, by-and-by, they will find that things are not likely to be so bad as they now promise; it would then be easier to expand than to contract in the event of the reverse, being the case. Of course this general contraction in business will make the labor market even duller than it is at present. This is unfortunate, as the bravest of the burden will, of course, fall upon those who are least able to bear it. But the difficulty is to be squarely met, and the sooner and more determinedly it is faced the more speedily it will be overcome. We should, therefore, put ourselves in the best possible shape to overcome the difficulties which await us.

PROSPECTS OF THE WAR.

According to some sensational journals, England has been as incensed during into a war with Russia as it is possible. It has been asserted that she would not admit the principle of separate negotiations between Russia and Turkey, as Austria, Germany, and Italy have already done. The London *Times*, however, in very forcible language points out the insanity of a repetition of the Crimean War policy, as it is not likely to be repeated for the present critical juncture.

It is now alleged that England recommends Turkey to treat separately with the Russians for peace, and it is believed the Porte will act upon the advice. Thus far, a *secret* has been maintained with Russia, but the British Ambassador has been avoided. On what terms of peace the Crim may be willing to treat with Turkey is yet unknown? The war party in Constantinople are disposed to give treacherous and clamorous for the return of Michael Pasha, who is now on a mission to the Court of St. James. An insurrection is apprehended. The fortifications of the city are complete, and it is believed, impregnable. The Russians occupy Suda, which gives them a base for operations in Rumania, and opens up the resources of the country around and makes them to a certain extent independent of supplies from Rumania. A drawn battle seems to have been fought between the Turks and Russians at Petrikof. The Serians do not appear to have been successful in their last engagement with the Turks. The Danube is said to be now thoroughly frozen over, thus rendering the passage of troops easy.

An effort is being made to change the hours of opening the Ontario Legislature and carrying on its business. Many object the late session of the House, and are in favor of having a forenoon session from eleven to two p.m., then a second from three to six, when the business of the House would be closed for the day. It is proposed that the Committee, which now meets in the forenoon, could have their sittings at night. The proposed change is a good one. It would greatly benefit the health of members, and would in no way retard public business.

A CASE OF BABY FARMING.

The neighborhood of Dan Mount is in a fever of excitement over the arrest of a woman named Matilda Willoughby, an alleged keeper of a private lying-in hospital, on a charge of killing an infant child by administering paregoric. The particular, as far as they have come to light, are these: In the early part of August last Mrs. Willoughby rented houses on De Grassie street, and opened an hospital for the care of infants. For several months her business remained a secret to the neighbors, but the frequency with which funerals occurred from her house aroused the suspicions of those living near, and the matter was fully talked about. No action was taken, however, until Friday, when a girl named McCaffrey, informed the authorities that what was going on, and swore out a warrant against Mrs. Willoughby. It appears that McCaffrey, some three months ago, entered the hospital and had a child on the 7th December last. Upon recovering, she complained to Mrs. Willoughby that her child was not being properly cared for, the complaint being followed by a quarrel between the two. This caused Mrs. Willoughby's arrest, which was made by Constable H. L. T. The woman is charged before Mr. D. J. P. and was committed to trial without bail.
