Creedy to animals. On Tuesday afternoon Mr. Robert Nixon, of Esqueping, near Speyside, was brought before Magistrate Christie, Campbell and Storey, to answer to the above charge, which was preferred by Mr. G. Forbes, Village constable. As far as we could learn the facts of the case are as follows:—On Friday last Mr. Nixon went to Silver Creek to get a mare which he had had some bargain about at the Georgetown Fair, and when he started it out of the stable and had proceeded a short distance up the hill this side of Silver Creek the mare fell down, and he found it impossible to make it get up again. A crowd gathered, and he, with the assistance of some present, fastened a chain to the martingale and dragged the animal back to the stable, a distance of about one hundred yards, where he left it all night. He returned the next day, and succeeded in getting the horse, allowing it to follow his sleigh, as far as Campbell's Hotel, Acton, when it again gave out, and was stalled there until Monday night, when Nixon again endeavored to hitch it up and get home. He put on the harness and fastened it to his sleigh, but had not got only as far as the street, in front of the hotel, when the horse again fell down, and it was with difficulty that it was got on its side, where it was left all night, in a dying condition, with no protection against the keen night air and chilly blasts save an old blanket which was thrown over it. In the morning it was found lying on its side bleeding at the nose, and it died about 9:30 o'clock. It was a pitiable sight. Constable Forbes immediately had the body removed, and he arrested R. Nixon on the charge of "cruelty to animals." The case came before the Magistrate's court on Tuesday afternoon and after hearing the evidence they order that he pay a fine of \$2.00, and costs, \$3.75 making \$5.75, allowing ten days to pay it. This should be a warning to several people of this vicinity who are frequently seen abusing horses and other animals in different manners.
