Prorogation of Parliament.

The first session of the Fourth Parliament of the Dominion of Canada was closed on Thursday last by the Governor-General delivering the following speech:

SPEECH:

Honorable Gentlemen of the Senate:
Gentlemen of the House of Commons:

I desire to thank you for the diligence and care with which you have discharged your duties this laborious and protracted session.

The re-organization of the important Department of Public Works and the division of its duties will, I doubt not, greatly add to the efficiency of the public service.

The consideration amendment of the bill relating to the lands of the Dominion will present to the large number of settlers now sending their way to the North West Territories a comprehensive and well considered system.

I hope that the bill relating to weights and measures, while it relaxes the stringency of previous legislation will not decrease the efficiency of that important measure.

The provision made for telegraphic communication between the mainland, Anticosti and the Magdalen Islands will facilitate and aid our commerce and navigation, and especially the development of our fisheries.

The measure adapted for the vigorous prosecution of the Canadian Pacific Railways hold out a prospect of the early completion of that great undertaking, and the proposed purchase from the Grand Trunk Railway Company of the line from Kitchener to Quebec, when concluded will at last complete the connection entered into at the time of Confederation to connect by an inter-colonial railway the St. Lawrence with the Atlantic ocean at Halifax.

I congratulate you on the other measures affecting the public interests which have been passed.

Speech of the House of Commons:

In Her Majesty's name I thank you for the supplies you have so readily granted. They will be expended with due regard to economy.

Honorable Gentlemen of the Senate and Gentlemen of the House of Commons:

The readjustment of the tariff which has been effected by the legislature of the province will I trust, by increasing the revenue restore the equilibrium between revenue and expenditure, while it will at the same time aid the development of our various industries and tend to remove the long continued financial and commercial depression which has so greatly retarded the progress of Canada.

I bid you now farewell, and desire to express my earnest hope that when Parliament again assembles we shall find the country enjoying the state of peace which now happily exists within its borders, together with a great exertion to the national prosperity.

Who Shall not Vote.

The following section 4 of the Election Act, is published for general information.—The chief justice and the justices of the court of appeal, the chancellor and vice-chancellor of Ontario, all clerks of the peace, county attorneys, registrars, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, deputy clerks of the crown, and agents for the sale of crown lands, all postmasters in cities and towns, and all officers employed, in the collection of any dues payable to Her Majesty in the nature of duties of excise, shall be disqualified and incompetent to vote at any election; and if any public officer or person mentioned in this section votes at any such election, he shall thereby forfeit the sum of two thousand dollars, and his vote at such election shall be null and void.
