During the past two weeks a petition to the Municipal Council, praying that in view of the existing necessity for a suitable place for the burial of the dead, that they take into favourable consideration the report of the committee appointed to examine and report on a suitable site, and that they make such arrangements for the purchase of a portion of land desirable for a cemetery, has been circulated among the taxpayers of this municipality, but has not met with the attention which it should receive. Why such is the case we are unable to determine, as it is obvious to all that steps should be taken for the purchase and opening of a new cemetery, and we would urge all ratepayers to give in their signatures at once, so that the petition may be presented to the council at its next meeting, that they may proceed with the question without delay.

### THE SCOTT ACT IN HALTON.

### YELLOW FEVER.

Yellow fever, when once it has appeared at a place where the temperature remains about 75 degrees, has rarely ceased its ravages until the coming of frost. The feeling of alarm among the people of the Southern States on the reappearance of yellow fever has not yet subsided, although no new cases have been reported within the last two or three days. Immediately the news of a single fatal case reached Chicago there was a fall in the price of the produce markets. During the day the price declined nearly 10 per cent. Short crops, the leading cause of meat dearth, 132 per cent, and lead also fell, though popularly supposed to be upheld by Eastern capitalists. The panic extended to breadstuffs, they declined about 7 per cent. This year the disease has appeared earlier than in previous years. The first case of the fever in Memphis was discovered last year on August 12, and within 24 hours 1,200 people had left the city. Within the next 37 days, 1,200 people died from the disease, out of a remaining population of 15,000—a proportion of loss which is scarcely ever equalled in any great battle. Since that time the city has been well drained, and the prospects are more hopeful.
