TUERDAY AFTERNOON, August 9, 1881 Observations on the Chronology of the Kings of Judah and Inracl.

It has been held by many entirent and learned chronologists, that the chronological details of the Book of Kings are contradictory, irreconcitable, and inexplicable. The accompanying table is an attempt to show that the difficulties connected with these details ere not insurmountable, that the dates are trustworthy, and that there is an exact arstem of chronology laid down in these books. The plan adopted by the Hebrew chronologist accomplishes

three important objects : . 1st. It shows the contemporaneous sovereigns in the parallel lines of

2nd, It excludes errors resulting from fragments of years at the beginning or end of reigns.

3rd. It affords a means of checking the total sum of the regual years of both lines of kings.

The plan by which these important objects and lattained is simple. The year in which a sovereign of the one line ascends the throne is synchronized with the regnal year of the contemporancous socceeign in the other. The chronological details are thus interwoven, and a continuous check is maintained throughout the whole perfod of the monarchy of Israel.

2 Eract synchronistic definitions respecting the regust era of each king Jehoram. is rendered necessary from the frequent occurrence of joint reigns in both lines of kings. The recognition of the fuct of foint reigns is the key to the whole chronological system of the monurchical period. The rejection of the evidence in support of joint reigns leads to end less difficulties and inextricule con fusion.
