VILLAGE VARIETIES.

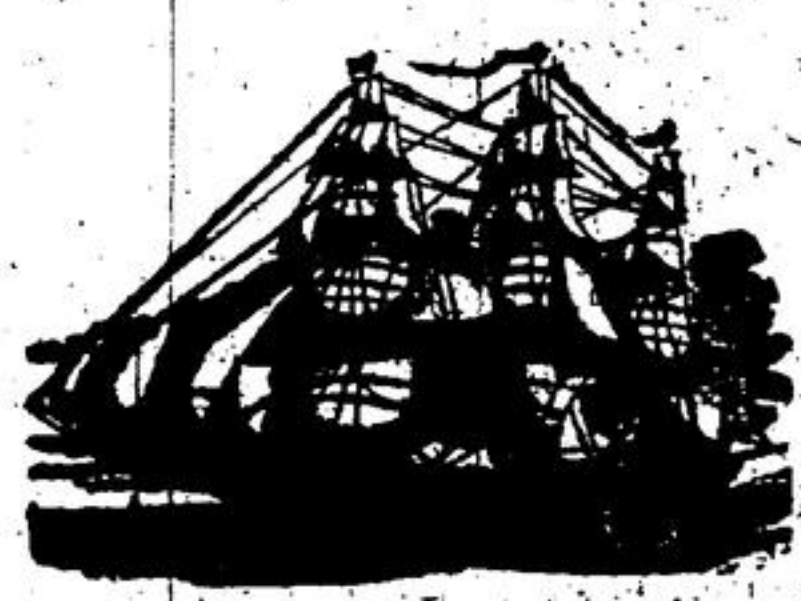
A collection of local news and other matters of special interest to our Village Readers. Yesterday was Court day. Action Brass Band Concert next Tuesday evening.
