HALTON COUNTY SCHOOLS. The minutes, etc., of the County Council for 1882, has been received. Important among other matters contained in this volume is the annual report of R. Little, Esq., Public School Inspector of the county, from which we glean the following interesting facts:—

RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES. The total receipts from all sources, including the balances from 1881, amounted to \$21,162.44—Increase, \$8,735.70. The total expenditure for the year amounted to \$14,019.22—Increase, \$7,165.41. The disbursements were as follows: For teachers' salaries, \$30,506.15—decrease, \$14,560.
