It is made to the readers of the Free Press that the existing partnership will be dissolved and the business of the present firm of J. D. Williamson & Co. discontinued at the end of the present season.

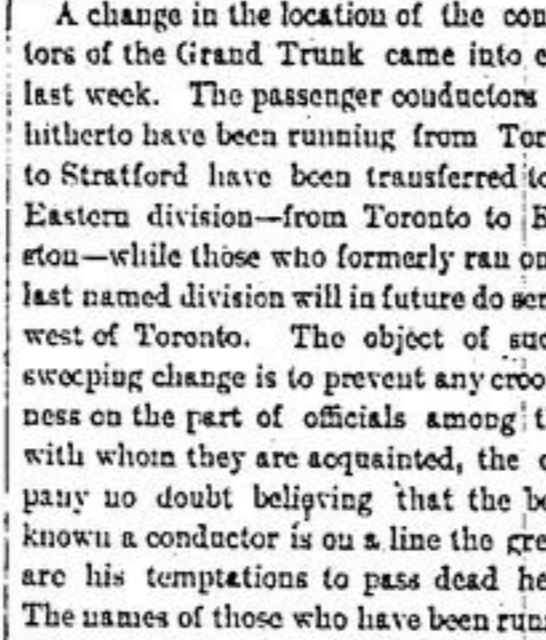

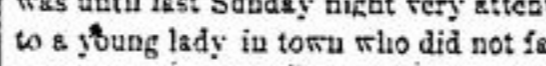
