NOTES AND COMMENTS.

In the Ontario Legislature, last week it was decided to continue the exhibit to the Provincial Exhibition one year longer.

The Pope is reported to be uneasy over the anti-Semitic agitation in Canada. It is said he fears that if a bitter feeling should arise it might cause serious complications.

At a meeting of the Young Liberal-Conservative of Toronto last Monday night a series of resolutions were submitted vigorously protesting against the privileges granted the Roman Catholic Church in the Province of Quebec.

Toronto Industrial Fair receipts last year were \$11,875.63 and expenses \$11,764. Admissions fees and children's fees amounted to \$60,000. It is the intention of the management to restrict and reduce the free admission list. The Fair this year will be held from the 19th to the 21st Sept.

The revised statistics for 1899 contain changes in the registry act. For instance, deaths must be registered by the person in whose house the death occurs, and before the burial of the body. Any person failing to comply with the law is liable to a fine. Readers will do well to remember this advice.

Within the last week or so the Treasurer of Ontario and Quebec have presented their respective provincial statements. The latter claim a surplus on the year's transaction of \$77,150, and the former of \$51,173. The liabilities of Quebec were also above assets as placed at \$11,892,479, while Ontario shows a surplus of \$3,781,416.

The assessor are about to commence their annual duties. Nearly every young man who is a British subject and 21 years of age will have himself almost wholly to blame if he has not a vote in Ontario. See the assessor in your municipality and get him to insert your name on the roll, if you do not, it will require an application on a prescribed form taken before a J. P., and then forwarded to him. If you are entitled to a vote under the act, see the assessor at once.

Smallpox at Fingal, Ont.

St. Thomas, Feb. 23.—There now seems no reason to doubt that the epidemic which has been prevalent in the vicinity of Fingal for some time past is the smallpox. The Fingal Board of Health has ordered the schools, churches and places of entertainment closed. A municipality vaccination has been decided upon. The city board of health met this evening to take measures to prevent the spread of the disease to this city.

Allison Herald Burned.

Alton, Feb. 23.—About 3 o'clock this morning the Herald printing and publishing office was burned down. The fire originated from the explosion of a lamp. The loss to the Herald is \$2100, insurance \$1500; buildings owned by George Kearns, loss \$700, insurance \$1000; O. McNeill's barber shop adjoining was totally destroyed, loss \$800, insurance nil. The energetic proprietors of the Herald, Mr. Newton, has already made arrangements for the issue of next week's paper, having secured new quarters.

SNASH AT MOUNT FOREST.

Four Engines and a Snowplough Wrecked—No Lives Lost.

Monte Forest, Feb. 25.—A smash-up on the Teeswater branch of the Canadian Pacific railway occurred at this point at two o'clock on Sunday morning, owing to the heavy snowstorm. The train, consisting of two engines, van, and first and second coaches, had orders to cross the plough and two engines here. The train had apparently spread at the switches, allowing the tender to jump the track, the two engines breaking loose. The baggage car struck the tank, damaging it, and the coaches following into the rails and scattered all over the place. The two engines which broke loose kept on, and ran for a mile and a quarter at a great speed, and finally stuck in a snow drift. The plough from Teeswater with two engines ran into them, completely wrecking the four engines and knocking the plough into kindling wood. Fortunately no lives were lost.

At all events everyone looks for a great piece of comedy from Blake when the Irish question comes up. The resolutions are too long to remember, but they seem to have been granted to Ireland.

Nicolas Flood Davin, the member from Regina, who once ran in Hamilton in the wit and the buffoon of the House, going to the robbins with veridical ease but tumbling almost at once into the ridiculous. THE PROHIBITION VOTE.
Mr. Jamieson's resolution for prohibition was passed by the House with a rider providing that prohibition should become law when the country is ready for its reception and enforcement. Mr. Taylor's amendment for a plebiscite and compensation was lost by a large majority. The temperance or prohibition vote numbered 68. Many temperance members expressed themselves against the introduction of the motion every session.

INDUSTRIAL CATASTROPHES.
At a caucus of Government supporters it is asserted and denied that the Fenwick Bill was discussed. It is a fact, however, that the Premier told them not to ask or press for railway subsidies or other money grants as economy was to be the watchword. He also said that the voters lists would be revised annually, but he did not see why the general election should come on until 1911.

TARIFF CHANGES.
Messrs. Foster and Bowell have been deluged with deputations asking for changes in the iron, fruit, flour, brandy, coconut and other duties. To-day's deputation asks that the request of yesterday's be refused and so on which means that the Government moves (all) will be found. The ministers met with no encouragement in their effort to secure an increase of duty of four from fifty cents to one dollar. The minister lumber department was received in the Privy Council room by the whole cabinet who listened to arguments in favor of abolishing the export duty of 65 a thousand feet on logs.

THE FOURTH ESTATE.

The Winter Session held in Toronto last week was the most successful in the Canadian Press Association's history.

FRANCICAL ESSAYS READ AND DISCUSSED.
The winter session of the Canadian Press Association was held in the cozy rooms of the Toronto Press Club last Friday and proved thoroughly practical and of great interest and profit to the large number of members assembled.

The following report from the Toronto papers will be found generally interesting: **MORNING SESSION.**
Rev. Dr. Dewar, the President, in the chair. The first paper was on "Subscriptions and Clubbing," by Mr. Roy V. Somerville, of Dundas. His paper was well prepared and comprehensive. Mr. Somerville argued that proprietors should make their subscription lists more of an asset instead of merely depending on it as a means of gaining advertisements. A publisher should regard his circulation with the same ideas and govern it with the same principles as any other business man does his stock in trade. He thought the publisher's duty should be the immediate vicinity of the office of publication. The proper manner to fill it was to recognize the importance of home news; giving special prominence to every local event; by not despising small items; keeping solid with ladies by publishing a good story.

Messrs. C. D. Barr, J. B. Traylor and J. C. Jamieson were appointed a committee to take charge of the evening dinner. After a discussion, in which many of the members gave their "experiences" relative to the subject treated in Mr. Somerville's paper, an adjournment was made until 2 o'clock.

THE AFTERNOON SESSION.
Mr. L. G. Jackson, Newmarket, read a paper on "Apprenticeship." Mr. Jackson deplored the practice of youths, who, undisciplined, can leave an office after a couple of years and walk forth, call themselves journeymen, and do botched work. His remedy was to indenture all apprentices for five years. At the conclusion of his paper he made the following motion:—
Resolved, that this association recognize the apprenticeship term of five years as requisite to qualify for a journeyman, and call upon all its members to duly observe the same; also that no member of this association shall engage an "apprentice" or "two-thirds" without a certificate from his former employer to the effect that he has left his employ with content.

Messrs. H. J. Scelgrove, W. R. Clime, E. P. Moore, Roy V. Somerville, J. B. Brierley, C. D. Barr and W. J. Watson spoke on the subject. The predominance of opinion was that while a term of five years was desirable indentures were hardly practicable. On motion the paper and resolution were referred to a committee composed of Messrs. W. R. Clime, J. B. Brierley, Roy V. Somerville, J. B. Brierley, C. D. Barr and E. G. Jackson.

Mr. C. D. Barr read a paper on "Advertising Rates, Local and Foreign." He urged his conference to fix rates or contract figures and stick to them.

Mr. J. B. Traylor introduced the advertising agent side of the question and asked what the press should do with him, giving many reasons why his role should be abolished or regulated. The phase of the question being brought before the meeting, Messrs. Jamieson, Watson, Somerville, Cameron and Brierley attacked it.

A desire being expressed for a suggestion of a basis for a rate per thousand of circulation for patent medicine advertisements, Messrs. Somerville, Jackson, Traylor, Campbell, Jamieson, Shannon, Hough and C. B. Robinson were appointed a committee to formulate such a list of rates.

A paper on "Business Office Management" by Mr. J. B. Traylor, was read. He deprecated the imperfect system of book keeping too often in vogue in newspaper offices and suggested a system complete and efficient. His paper dealt with discipline in the office and the necessity for well observed rules in all departments and for the calculation of the cost and profit of all work being done.

Then came a discussion on the usefulness of a job ticket, Messrs. Somerville, Watson and Barr taking part in it.

Mr. H. P. Moore read a paper on "Job Printing"—what is a fair price for a job printing corporation which endeavors to "squeeze out small offices" were notified and after enunciating some sound principles he came to the question of profit. After the cost of material, composition and press work there should be added 30 per cent. for rent and interest on capital invested, etc., and 25 per cent. for profit. The large printers, as canvassers from city houses in the smaller towns are called, were held up to obloquy. The best way of keeping up reasonable prices was discussed, and a dozen members found their tongues loosened and talked on this question.

The duty on plates was considered, and the matter was referred to the Executive Committee with instructions to take any necessary measures to oppose the increase of the duty on newspaper plate matter.
