The Senate Bill - The Position at Ottawa The Scott Act Contingency - The C.P.R. Bill.

OTTAWA, March 26.—So many columns have been written about the Senate Act of the Quebec Legislature that most people would take the origin of the matter in a few words.

THE SENATE AT OTTAWA. The Senate Bill like all other bills was transmitted to Ottawa for Federal review.

Today at four o'clock O'Brien will in the House of Commons move that the Senate Bill be passed. The debate promises to be prolonged and may last till Friday night.

There is only one point outside Ontario. The total majority by which the Act was adopted in these places in 1885 was 12,627. Those entitled to vote for candidates for the House of Commons are entitled to vote on the Scott Act.

THE C.P.R. BILL has passed the Railway Committee on a division after being remodelled. The conversion of the bill into a bill agreed to by the shareholders first.

The Government will abandon their bill respecting bills, checks and promissory notes. It would prolong the season. As it is there will be difficulty in getting through by Easter.
