TERRIBLE R.R. ACCIDENT

Trains on the Grand Trunk Crash into Each Other at Merriton. THREE KILLED, 12 WOUNDED.

Merriton, July 15.—Special.—A terrible accident occurred about 10:30 this morning on the Grand Trunk division of the Great Western Railway, between the stations of Merriton and a half mile beyond. The train from Toronto, consisting of a passenger car, a baggage car, and a freight car, was moving westward. The train from Merriton, consisting of a passenger car, a baggage car, and a freight car, was moving eastward. The two trains collided, and the passenger cars were crushed. Three people were killed and twelve were wounded. The cause of the accident is being investigated.

On Wednesday last week, the United States Senate by a vote of 61 to 34 approved the \$5,000,000 appropriation for the Columbian Exposition.
