### NOTES AND COMMENTS.

It is thought that Parliament will meet  
for the despatch of business about the end  
of January, and that this is generally ex-  
pected is indicated by the increased num-  
ber of notices in The Canadian Gazette  
of applications for mail charters or amend-  
ments to old ones. Six such notices  
appeared in last week's issue.

The world's greatest pest hole is at  
last to be closed. The Sultan has resolved  
to put Mecca into something like a healthy  
condition. The decision is the effect of an  
intimation from the British Government  
that unless the whole city is cleaned it will  
take means to prevent the annual pilgrimage  
from India. The Sultan has decided  
not only to cleanse the town, but to erect  
at his personal cost a great lodging house  
capable of containing 5,000 persons.

The Finance Minister has signified his  
intention of introducing a federal mon-  
etary act to the notice of the cabinet, and  
as strong pressure has been brought to bear  
on the Government in this matter it is  
likely that the desired legislation will be  
passed at the next session in the house.  
Complaints have been loud and so numer-  
ous of late that the Government could  
hardly afford to continue to ignore the re-  
quests of the business men.

The question of the coming vote on Pro-  
hibition will not be allowed to get mixed  
up with politics, and prohibition workers  
will make a mistake if they allow themselves  
either to be partisans or to be identified
