HOW BIG CANADA IS.

“The Dominion Compared with Other Nations of the Earth.”

A Swedish journalist, Mr. A. E. E. has traveled a good deal in America, and is evidently greatly impressed with the greatness of Canada and the remoteness and climate. In quiet language he makes comparisons of Canada and other countries in his paper, the *Linköping Tidningen*, from which the following is taken:

I have travelled for two months in Canada and United States. During this journey I have four times gone over the New World between the great sea and the Pacific ocean. Several times I have travelled from north to south over the big parts of America. I have been reading hundreds of pamphlets about several states, and I have compared their statements with actual circumstances. I have gone over the mountains through the great valleys of Europe, over mountains with eternal snow and through valleys of eternal snow. I have been in inhabited like the paradise and in uninhabited like the desert. I have heard the discussions of the Pacific and United States, and I have seen the Prime Minister in another state. I have talked to leaders of political parties, to some of the highest authorities in the States and to hundreds of citizens.

In the United States there are more than 200,000,000 of acres of free land, that is a fact. But the most of it is in a desert. So it is with Dakota, Montana, Idaho and the eastern part of Washington, and many states west from there are of the same character. You can travel in half a day without seeing a house. The grass is not and dry, in many places you cannot find any grass at all, only some singular pieces of earth and sand. Now even close to the steppes you will not see a house.

Taking a train going north we come to Canada. It is a beautiful country and a beautiful land. The land part of the west in the United States are brown, Canada is green. The first part we see of this land is a meadow, level as a floor, infinite as the sea, and wearing a billowing dress of grass and flowers.

After this we pass other meadows, meadows and if the grass there is not so high and green, the land anyway is much better than the deserts in the neighboring republic.

These meadows meadows are the great ones. The real meadows you will find in Canada, innumerable paths, trodden by the buffalo, extend over these plains. Fine as the prairie and green and very often cultivated, but more beautiful and more available for cultivation are the small meadows and groves. These small prairie occupy an area bigger part of Canada than the great prairie. But if the reader shall be able to understand anything about Canada, he first must know how great Canada is.
