THE COUNCIL'S LAST SESSION—The last session of the County Council was held in the Court House, Milton, on Tuesday. The business of the year, being completed, the Council adjourned at two o'clock. They were cordially invited, together with a large number of other guests, to the Wallace House, where a sumptuous luncheon was provided by the Warden. About sixty guests were present, including the members of the County Council, Mr. Warren's colleagues in the township, and representative men of the county. The chairs were occupied by the Hon. Justice Judge Snyder, Mr. D. H. Menzies, Mr. C. G. Martati, of Oakville. The dinner was an excellent one, the table decorations most attractive and all the arrangements reflected credit upon the host, Mr. E. Mitchell.

An amendment to the bill law has been introduced into the Vermont Legislature. The City of New York, at the recent state elections, voted on the "Greater New York" scheme, and will now try to amalgamate about a dozen outlying suburbs, including Brooklyn, Long Island City, Mount Vernon, Flushing and several other suburbs. When consolidation is completed

New York will have an area of 318 square miles and three and a quarter millions of people, making it the second city in the world.

Denmark has forbidden the import of live cattle and fresh meat from the United States. As Denmark uses very little American beef or meat products, this action is probably due to a request from Germany, as beef received at Danish ports frequently would find its way into Germany, and thus overcome the German restriction, which has been imposed, it is believed, on account of the hostile sugar legislation of the U. S. Senate.

The last cattle shipment from Montreal this season was made last week on the steamship Storm King, which carried forty cattle and more than two thousand sheep. The total number of cattle shipped during the season is 30,000 head, and 13,747 sheep, as compared with 33,322 cattle and 3,717 sheep during 1893. The reason for the small shipment of sheep is due to the fact that a profitable market has been found for them in Great Britain. More than 6,000 horses were shipped during the season.

Canadians, says the Canadian *Advertiser* in London, are naturally watching with keen interest the result of the trials shipments of live cattle and sheep from Australia to England. The first cargo of cattle yielded a loss of just £5 per head. The second, which had been sold, reduced the loss to £4 per head, or at least the Standard estimates. As to the sheep shipped alive, they realized 20s each or just nearly enough to pay transport expenses, to say nothing of first cost. These were, of course, small shipments, and it remains to be seen whether large cargoes would yield discouraging returns.

The New York *Times* pays this timely recognition of Canadian shipping: "It is not particularly creditable to America to enterize that the work of laying a cable across the Pacific should have been left to the Canadians. The commercial interests of our own Pacific coast with Asia, as well as with the islands of the Pacific, have for a generation and more been far more important than those of Canada. Yet we have relied for communication upon slow mail steamers, and have not established telegraphic communication with the Hawaiian Islands. The Canadians have taken great enterprise since the opening of the Canadian Pacific in diverting trade to that route, while the Californians seem to have been apathetic. The laying of a cable from Vancouver, instead of from San Francisco, will give the Canadians a very marked advantage in their effort to catch the Asiatic trade."
