Mr. H. Gardner, President of the Board of Agriculture, replying to questions by Mr. John Kinsley and Mr. Robert Ferguson in the House of Commons, said that the Government were doing everything possible to see to it that the Canadian cattle being unrestrictedly admitted into Great Britain this season.

Mr. William Horwood, Chancellor of the Exchequer, announced the budget last Thursday in the British House of Commons. The revenue for the past year, he said, had been \$1,914,000. The expenditure had been \$2,364,000. The surplus had been \$450,000.

It is stated on the best authority that when the Legislature of Manitoba meets this week to deal with the Separate School matter the answer to the remedial order will be "No," and the Government will then dissolve the Legislature and seek an expression of opinion upon its action.

The Supreme Court this week dismissed the appeal of the Dominion against the Province of Ontario and Quebec. Under the judgment the sum of \$600,000 is now sent to the provinces, representing the excess of interest on debt to which the provinces were entitled last year for the period between 1898 and 1873.
