MAINE AND OHIO. Here are figures that tell their own story and convey their own lessons. Maine thoroughly committed to prohibition Obio is a license State, filled with distilleries, breweries, and myriads of saloons Maine challenges comparison of its common people with that of the common people of Ohio. In population, indeed, the latter State far outstrips it. Population of Maine, 661,086; population of Ohin, 3,672, 816. That is, Ohio has five and a half times the population of Maine. Neverthe less. Maine has far more savings-bank deposits than Ohio. Deposits of Maine, \$53,897,590; deposits of Obio, \$84,606,218. Thus, though less than one-fifth in number, the people of Maine have more than half again as much laid up in the savings banks as the people of Ohio. Or, to put the fact in a different form, were the amounts deposited in the savings banks of Obio divided equally among its people, each person would receive \$9.42. But every inhabi of Maine would carry away \$80.77 were each to receive an equal share of its deposite. Or, there is deposited per head, less than an eighth in Ohio of the por

GIVE US GOOD ROADS.

We are convinced that before permanent mprovement can be made in our genera cond system, it will be necessary to adopt nore practical methods of road making than those which are now in vogue. will be necessary to interest the provincial government more thoroughly in the matter and awaken them to the necessity of more judicious expenditure of road monies In Ontario, a province noted for its stretches of good roads and for its rapid decrease of bad ones, the government appoint an instructor in road making, whose duty it is to furnish the district path masters with instructions as to how roads in each locality should be treated to effect most permanent improvement. It can readily be seen how a thoroughly competent man in such a position can exert

tremendous influence towards the betterment of exciting conditions. If the province needs a school of horticulture to teach farmers and farmers' sons scientific orcharding and general farming, it also needs a school to instruct these same farmers and farmers' sons in the scientific principles of road making, so that their crops may be the more easily marketed, and their properties correspondingly, onhanced in value. The one is as necessary as the other; and they are more closely related to each other than is generally recognized. We were ready to believe that path masters throughout the country would enlist in this good roads movement and study and adopt the ideas of progressive road builders, but the greater portion of the work done in this vicinity this spring has
